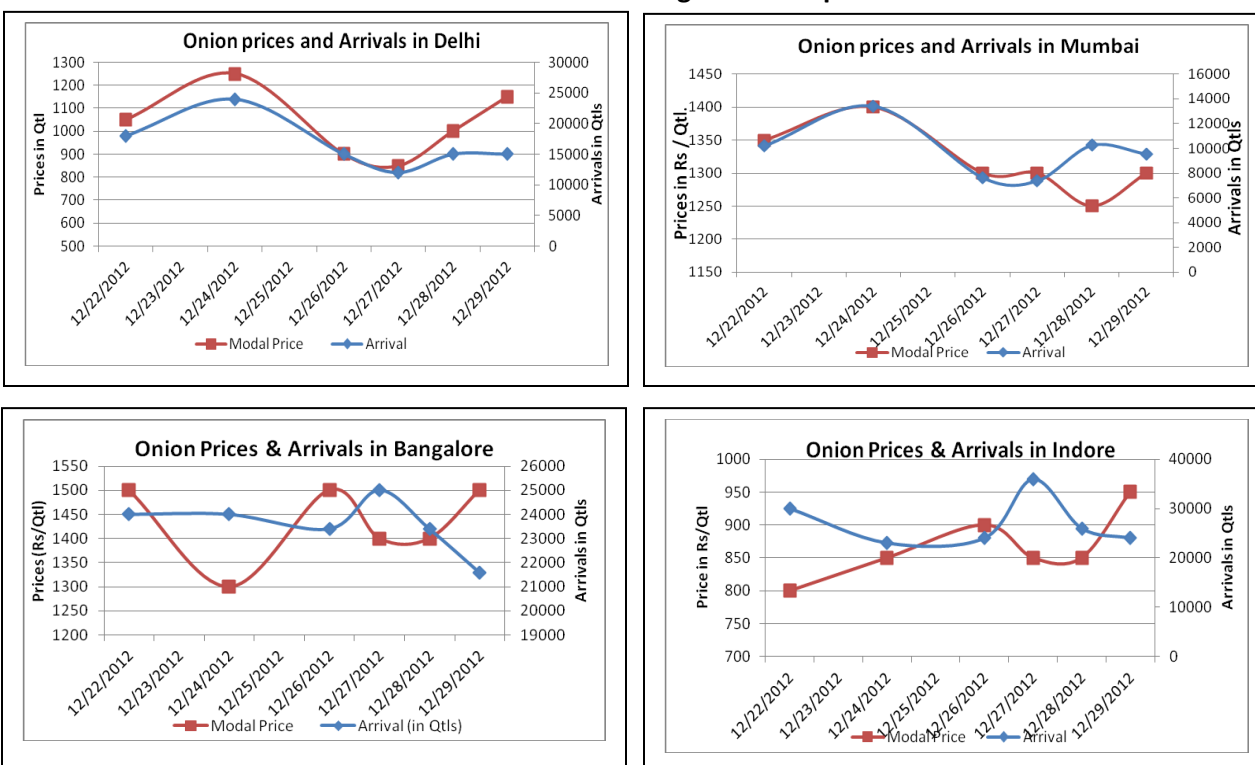


### Onion Fundamentals:

- According to trade sources in Maharashtra, prices have improved this week after being volatile throughout last week. Also, there was demand from Kolkata and Bangladesh this week.
- According to news sources, export demand is good especially from Srilanka. Exports to the South-East Asian region has been hit by problems at JNPT. As cargo movement at JNPT has affected due to workers strike.
- In Delhi, onion is mainly coming from Nasik and Khairthal near Alwar in Rajasthan. Average prices have increased to Rs 1100/ quintal from Rs 900/ quintal in last three days. The reason for increase in price is because of foggy weather which is creating problem in transportation.
- In Belgaum (Karnataka), onion is arriving in market from local region and Maharashtra region which are contributing approximately 85% and 15% respectively.
