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Commodity-wise Domestic, International Prices and Arrivals at Different Centers

Highlights-Domestic Market:

- Kharif pulses sowing has entered in the last phase now. Indian farmers have covered 134.57 lakh ha so far against 128.66 lakh ha last year as on 28th Aug-2020. It is almost 4.59 % higher than last year and over 104% of normal (128.89 lakh ha) till date. Tur area is up by 7.72 % to 47.1 lakh ha. Urad area too is higher by 1.16 % to 37.52 lakh ha so far against 37.09 lakh ha last year. Normal area is 35.53lakh ha. Indian farmers have showed more interest in moong farming and they have shown 34.85 lakh ha so far against 30.19 lakh ha last year. It is higher by 15.44 % from last year and higher by 4.29% of normal as on 28th Aug-2020. Kulthi sowing is up by 70 % at 0.17 lakh ha so far. Farmers have covered 14.93 lakh ha area under other pulses against 16.73 lakh ha last year. See details at page no -14.**
- Improved demand for tur and tur dal amid lower pace of import have helped market to trade up** by Rs 100-150 in various markets. Apart from renewed demand, arrivals in major markets is decreasing now. It may support tur cash market further this week to a certain extent. Demand for tur dal may increase in coming weeks. There is good planting of tur this year. Ample rains in major growing states like Karnataka, MH and UP are supportive for standing crop. No damage has been reported from any states so far. However, stock at port is lower and new crop is almost three months away from now. So, lemon tur price may increase to Rs 5800-5850 at Mumbai port while it may move up to Rs 6150-6250 in Gulberga and at Rs5700- 5850 in south Indian markets. The short-term sentiment seems firm. Govt. Import licenses may be delayed by a month or two despite letter written to Indian govt. regarding opening up of impot.
- Import timeline for urad ended on 31st Aug-2020 and there is no update regarding time line extension** from the DGFT so far. Even stockists have restricted selling sensing uptrend to continue. Demand may increase as hotels and shop outlets have started opening. The allocated 4 lakh MT urad imports will not be utilized by 31st Aug, given the current pace of imports. So, if the time line is not extended beyond Aug, prices of urad may move up again. Quotes for FAQ urad moved down by \$25 to \$760 per MT while SQ moved down to \$870 per MT basis Indian port. Prices in domestic market too improved by Rs 100 to Rs 6300 for FAQ and Rs 6800 for SQ. If demand improves and govt. maintains status quo for import deadline, prices could increase against normal expectation. So, the govt. decision on extending the deadline remains crucial in deciding the price trend in the coming weeks too..
- Demand for moong and arrivals are normal in the market at this point of time. Prices are mostly steady**, though pressure might begin when arrivals from new kharif season pick up in Karnataka. Besides, higher area coverage and good crop condition so far would not allow market to move up from current level. Arrival from MH is expected in the last week of Aug, followed by MP and Gujarat. Arrival from summer crop is almost over now. If demand improves, slight recovery might be seen this week. There is no parity for import as moong prices are ruling lower than Myanmar right now. Expecting a huge crop in Rajasthan, stockists are preferring to sell now. So, overall trend seems weak in the medium term despite minor loss in Karnataka (8000 ha) and Telangana (600 ha) by flooding. However, higher coverage area would compensate the loss easily.
- Improved demand for chana dal and decreasing arrival in major markets have helped chana market to move up** by Rs 200 more like previous week too. Artificial difference between demand and supply is being created by punters/brokers. it remains supportive for cash chana market right now. However, it is unlikely to sustain for a longer period as govt. has ample stock and Nafed would continue to sell through auction at improved price (around MSP level Rs 4875)). It would cap market at Rs 4800-5000. Chana is being traded at Rs 4900-5000 in Delhi market. Chana market is likely to sustain at this level. At this level selling by private trades is expected. If Nafed start selling at this level to cool down price, it would come down again. So overall sentiment seems weak in the medium term. If prices continue to move up, govt has option to slash import duty on chana (currently applicable at 60%). This year Australia crop is said to be bumper and would hit market in Oct.
- India imported around 1.67 lakh MT masur in July and volume is expected to increase to 2 to 2.5 lakh MT in August.** The reason behind higher import is reduced duty (10 instead of 30 %) till August. Price movement would depend on govt.s decision on current applicable duty. If govt extend time line for import with reduced duty, masur may trade down by

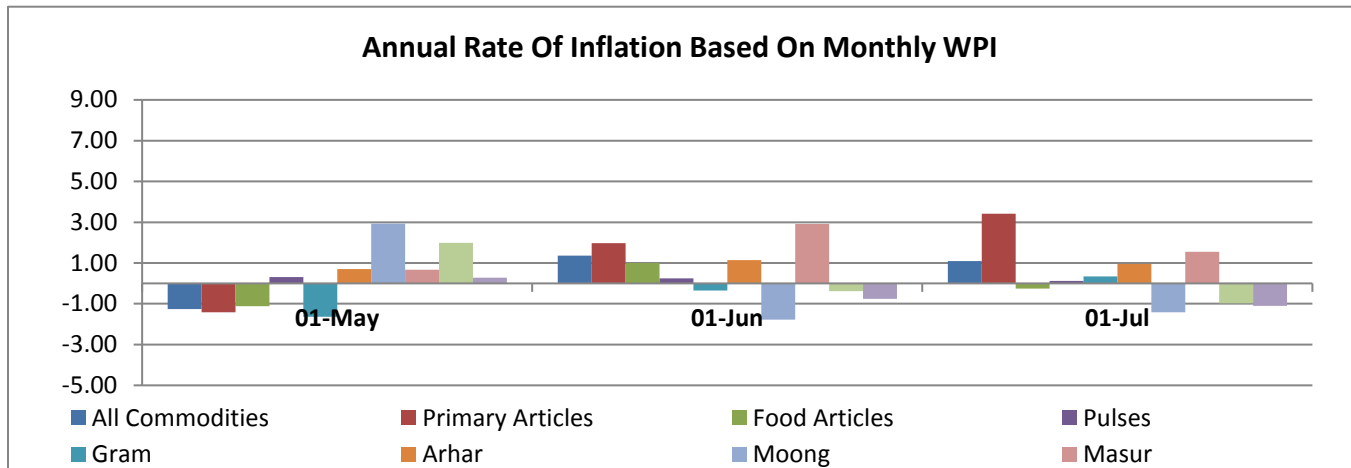
Rs200-300, otherwise it may move up by Rs300-400 again. Right now imported masur is being traded at Rs 5300-5350 at Mumbai. Masur and masur dal demand is normal while supply side in overseas market is increasing with commencement of harvesting in Canada and USA.

International Market Update:

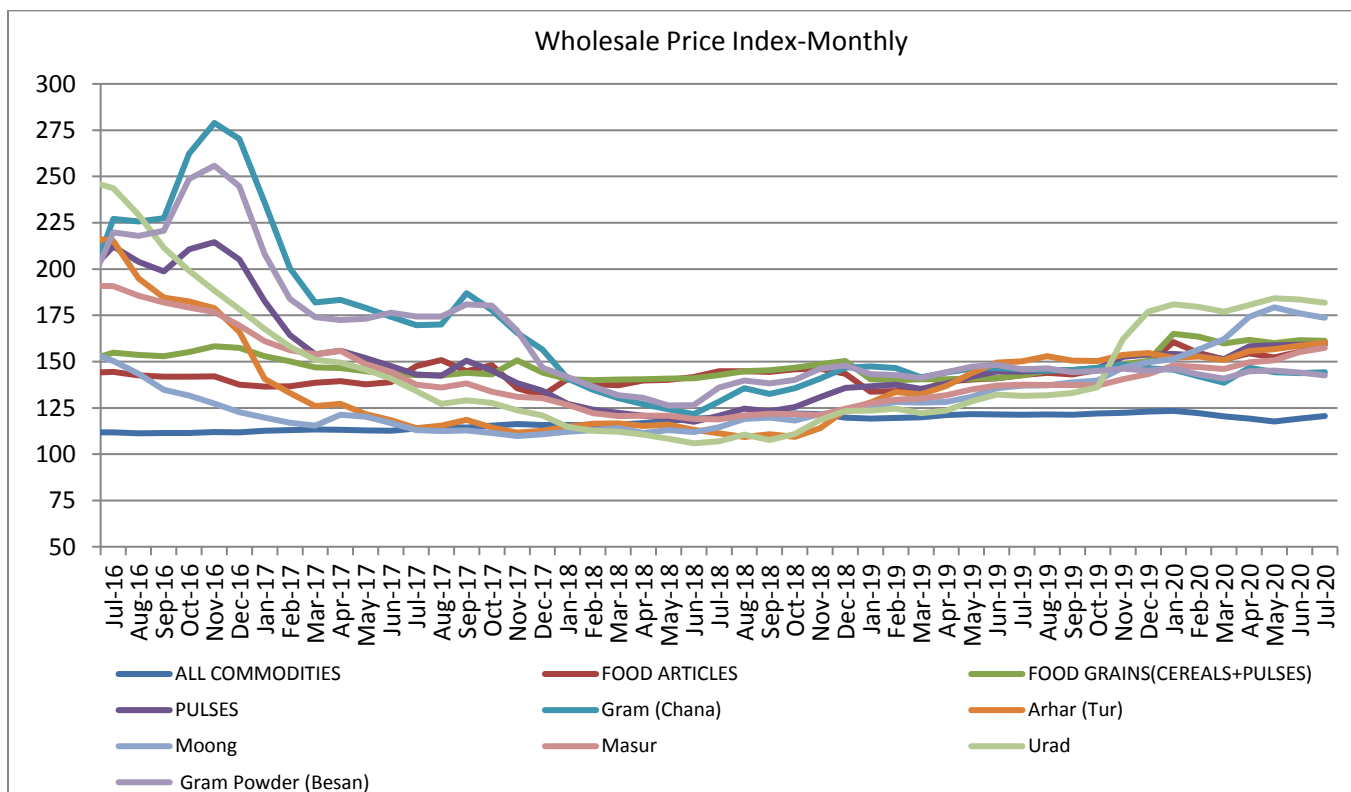
- **Stock position of urad in Myanmar is said to be around 2.75 to 3 lakh Mt. New crop is expected** to hit market in mid - March-2021. By then Myanmar may export around 1 lakh Mt under quota system before new crop hits the market and would consume 50,000 Mt for domestic consumption. If India extends time line for import, prices in Myanmar may move up by \$100 per Mt from current level. Myanmar is offering urad FAQ and SQ at \$720 and \$825 per Mt respectively right now. India govt may open import after accessing the kharif crop size and current loss. Actually price trend in Myanmar would depend on decision on import time line in India. Right now India is waiting for kharif crop, which is heading towards maturity and harvesting may commence in Sep.
- **Stock of Tur in Myanmar is said to be around 1.75 to 2 lakh Mt from 2019-20 crop while new crop is expected** in Feb 2021. Farmers are shifting 20% tur area to sesamum. Indian importers have struck deal of 25,000 Mt so far. As import remains restricted so Myanmar govt has written to Indian govt. to open import soon. However, Indian govt would not open import analysing the higher area coverage of tur and good crop condition so far. If prices continue to move up, govt may consider it to open in Oct-Nov for a limited period. Right now Myanmar is offering tur at \$625 per Mt basis FoB. Price trend would depend on Indian decision over import time line.
- **Global lentils market traded almost steady during the past week as exporters, traders and processors seem engaged** in accumulating new crop stocks from growers. Around 19 % harvest is completed now and around 500,000 metric tonnes (MT) of new crop is available to markets. Initial yield report is good so far. However, some yield loss might be seen in late sown crops due to moisture stress during pod filling and flowering stages.
- **Chickpeas traded flat with limited trading activity during the review week. Canada's harvest** has commenced now, while it started two weeks ago in the U.S. Pacific northwest and Montana. Production in Russia is expected to increase this year while production in Argentina may decrease by 50%. Production in Australia may increase considerably; its variety is desi type which may not compete with North American and Russian crops.
- **For 2020-21, Canadian lentil seeded area rose by 11.96 % to 1.72 Mha, due to good** forecasted returns compared to other crops. It was 1.53 Mha in 2019-20. By province, Saskatchewan accounts for 90% of the lentil area, with the remainder seeded in Alberta and Manitoba. Production is forecast to increase to 2.47 MMT (2.16 MMT last year), with supply lower due to smaller carry-in stocks. Exports are forecast to be lower at 2.1 MMT. Carry-out stocks are forecast to rise to nearly 0.175 MMT. The average price for all grades and types are forecast to rise from 2019-20, with higher prices from large green and red types. It may rule in the range of \$500-530 per metric tonne throughout the year. There is an expectation that import demand in the Indian subcontinent will continue to be similar or slightly higher in 2020-21. The data has been taken from the latest update from Agriculture & Agri food Canada.
- **For 2020-21, the area seeded under chickpeas in Canada fell by 23.89% from 159 thousand ha in 2019-20 to 121 thousand ha** due to the lower farm gate prices received in the previous year. Saskatchewan accounts for most of the chickpea area, with the remainder in Alberta. Production is forecast by AAFC at 200 Kt, down 20.63% from the previous year, due to lower seeded area despite higher expected yields. Supply is forecast to rise to 410 Kt. Exports are forecast to rise from 105 to 125 Kt and carry-out stocks are forecast to fall from 160 to 150 Kt in 2020-21. The average price is forecast to fall marginally due to a larger world supply, with the expectation of an average grade distribution. It may hover in the range of \$455 to \$485 per tonne.
- **Australia is going to plant its biggest chickpeas crop in comparison to last three years. Planting** continues in Queensland and NSW. As moisture level in the field is good, farmers are increasing area under chickpeas. As top level soil moisture is low, farmers are using wheat land for chickpeas planting. Forward delivery for October onward has been heard at \$ 630 per MT. New chickpeas crop may attract higher value. Value of new crop may be affected by any further hiccups caused by COVID-19. It may pressurize Chickpeas price.

- **As per latest updates by NASS, dry pea acreage may be down by 12-13% this year in US peas producing regions.** Farmers may plant 971,000 acres against 11,03,000 acres last year. Intended plantings are down from a year ago in Idaho, Montana, Nebraska, North Dakota, and South Dakota. However, area in Washington may increase by 19% this year.
 - **Chickpeas area in the US is likely to decrease by 32% from last year. Small chickpea acreage shows a decline of only 5%, while large chickpea acreage is expected to decrease by 41% .It is really a big surprise this year.**
- Monthly Outlook: -Pulses are likely to trade steady to slightly firm.**

Pulses WPI increased by 2 points from 159.2 in June to 159.4 in July-2020

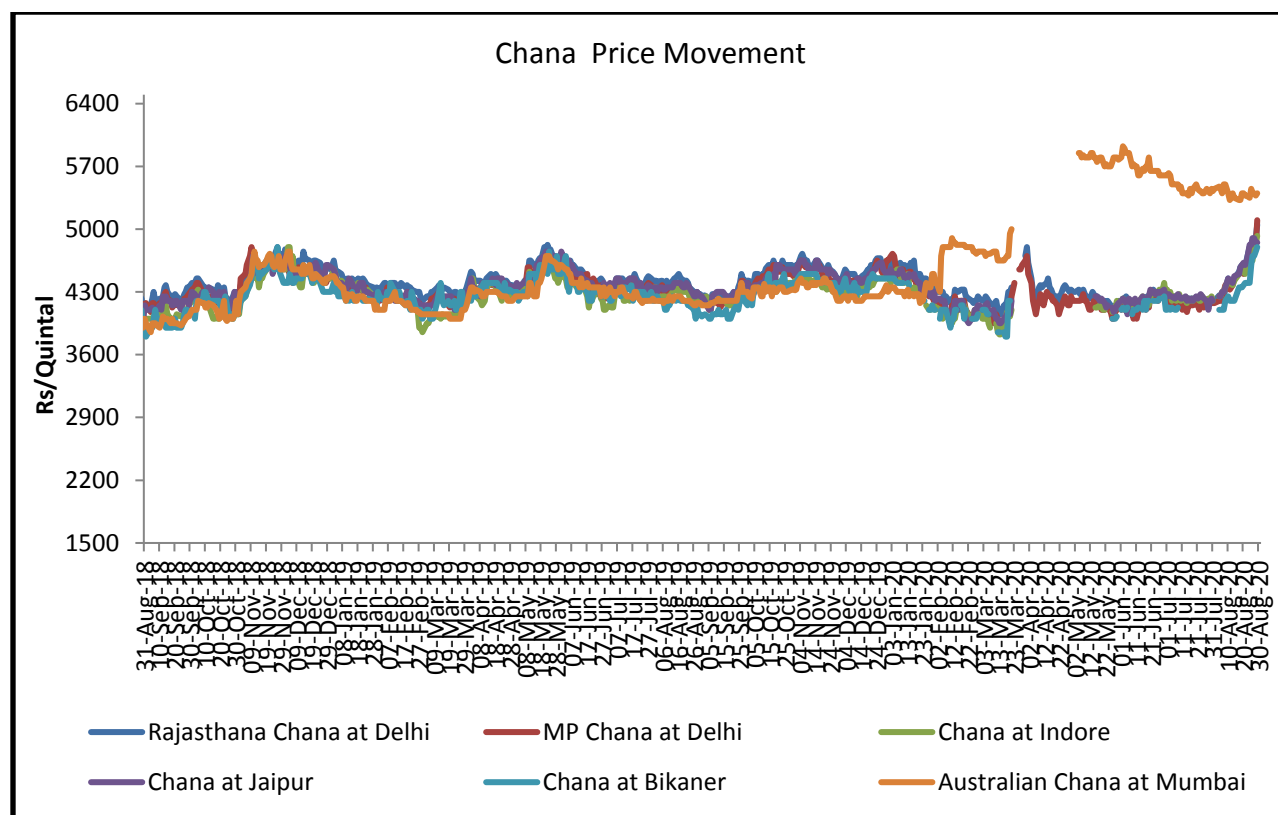
Pulses-Wise Scenario:

Chana

Current Scenario:

Chana cash market traded up taking clue from firm futures and improvement in dal demand. Besides, cancellation of bids below Rs 4750 by Nafed also helped the market to move up. Burden of 1MMT old stock has been neutralized by distributing it during lock down. Nafed has procured around 21.55 lakh MT chana against the target of 22.5 lakh MT this season. Procurement is over now and Nafed has 2.3 MMT (new) chana stock.. Nafed Karnataka has rejected all chana bids below 4750. This may push up price by another Rs 100-150 in coming days. In Delhi, Chana is being traded at Rs 4850-4950 and may move up by Rs 100 from current levels. Demand for chana is expected to improve further and help market to recover to a certain extent, even beyond MSP levels if import from LDC countries remains restricted. India imported around 27,000 Mt in July from LDC countries. Under prevailing condition overall short term sentiments seem firm for chana cash market as demand would continue to increase with market returning to normal path. In Delhi It may trade at Rs 4900-5100 in Sep.

All India average price for Chana increased by 7 % percent to 47505 per qtl. during review week. Even Australian Chana (imported) price increased by 2% to Rs 5590 per 100kg due to firm futures in domestic market. Following graph illustrates chana price movement in different markets:



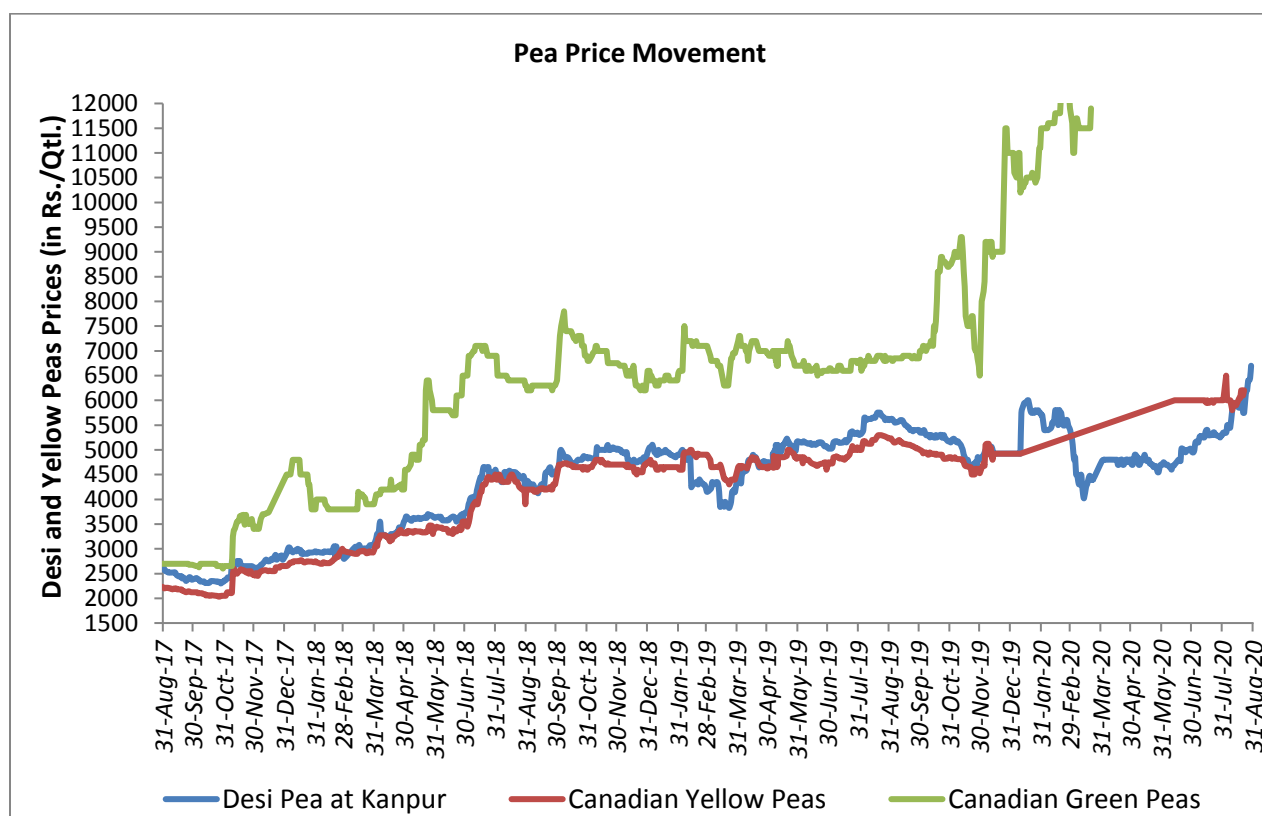
Market Outlook: Firm tone may continue in chana cash market this week too due to rejection of chana bids by Nafed below 4750 in Karnataka. Improvement for dal demand too remains supportive for cash market. Apart from this improved offtake from mills in other consuming states amid lower import volume from LDC countries may support upward momentum in the weeks ahead. Indian importers have imported around 3 lakh MT chana during April to July 2020 from LDC without tax. Demand for besan mills and hotel industry has started increasing now. Distribution of 1 k.g. dal per family/ per ration card would continue to affect direct demand from cash market till Nov. It would cap any unexpected spike in chana cash market.

Peas (Matar):

Market Recap:

Pea cash market traded firm taking clue from firm chana futures. However, stranded peas at ports are being released now with additional penalty and applicable duty. So after slight correction price will move up again. Stocks at port are dwindling and availability is decreasing continuously in major markets like Kanpur, MH, Kolkatta and Indore. However, demand at higher level may get disrupted and price may decrease again if chana trades lower. No import is taking place right now as import limit of 1.5 lakh MT has already been exhausted. With changed status from the free to restricted category and hefty levy imposed on peas, no import is likely in the coming months too. The commerce ministry issued a separate harmonized system (HS code) for all peas (including yellow, green dun and kaspas) and changed its status in the third week of Dec. Now import deals are not taking place given these changes aimed at increasing consumption of chana which is abundantly available in domestic market. Under prevailing conditions govt. is unlikely to allow green peas import. So price of yellow peas will also stay steady at current levels or follow the chana price trend.

Peas in Kanpur market also traded up at Rs 5650-5700 due to halted arrivals in domestic market and almost no import during last three months. Stockists too are unwilling to release old stock because of lower production this year. It may lend support to peas in Kanpur market. As supply side would increase with release stocks at ports, it may pressurize cash market to a certain extent. Demand for green pea is normal.

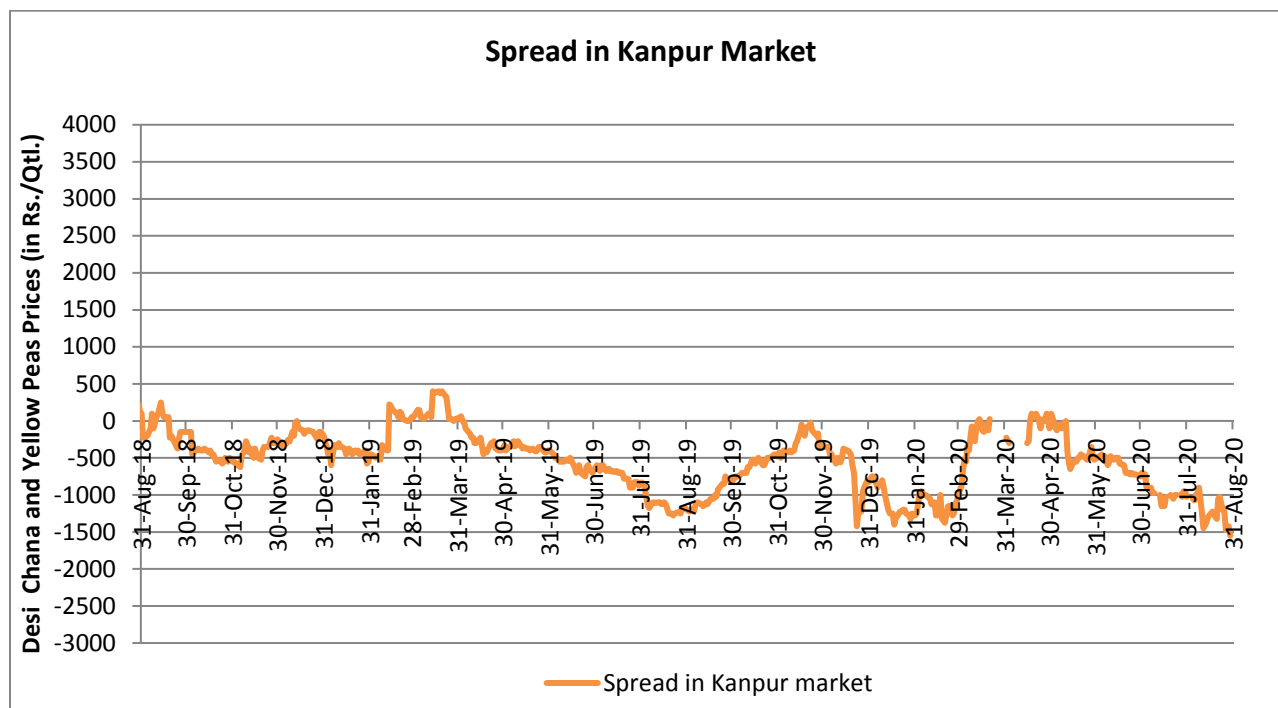


Current Market Dynamics & Outlook:

Peas market traded firm due to decreasing availability in domestic market and firming chana price. Kanpur market traded up by Rs200 to Rs 5700 per qtl. Any major spike is unlikely now. Recent release of pea at port may ease supply for a shorter period. So some downward correction is expected now. Overall, all India average price was up by 2.50% to Rs 6050-6150 per qtl. In Mumbai market, there was no quote for yellow peas as stock was exhausted. Demand and supply side is balanced right now. Canadian yellow pea is being traded at Rs 6100-6200.

Spread With Chana:

Spread between Chana and Peas, at Kanpur market remained in negative zone. Gap has decreased slightly from Rs 1175 to Rs 1475 due to increased pea price. Spread is expected to remain in the negative zone in Sep too on relative movement in Chana prices. Overall outlook seems steady to slightly weak this week too.



MarketOutlook: Outlook remains steady to slightly firm in the short to term.

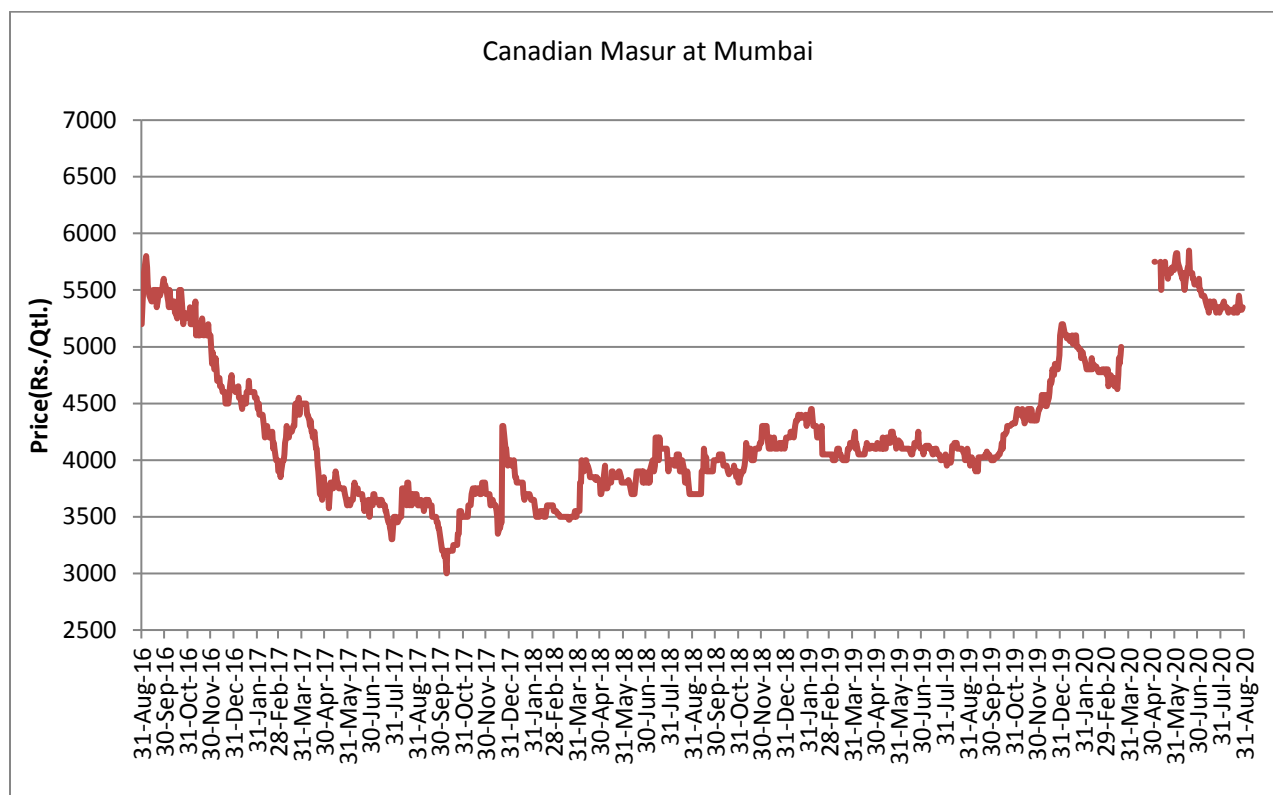
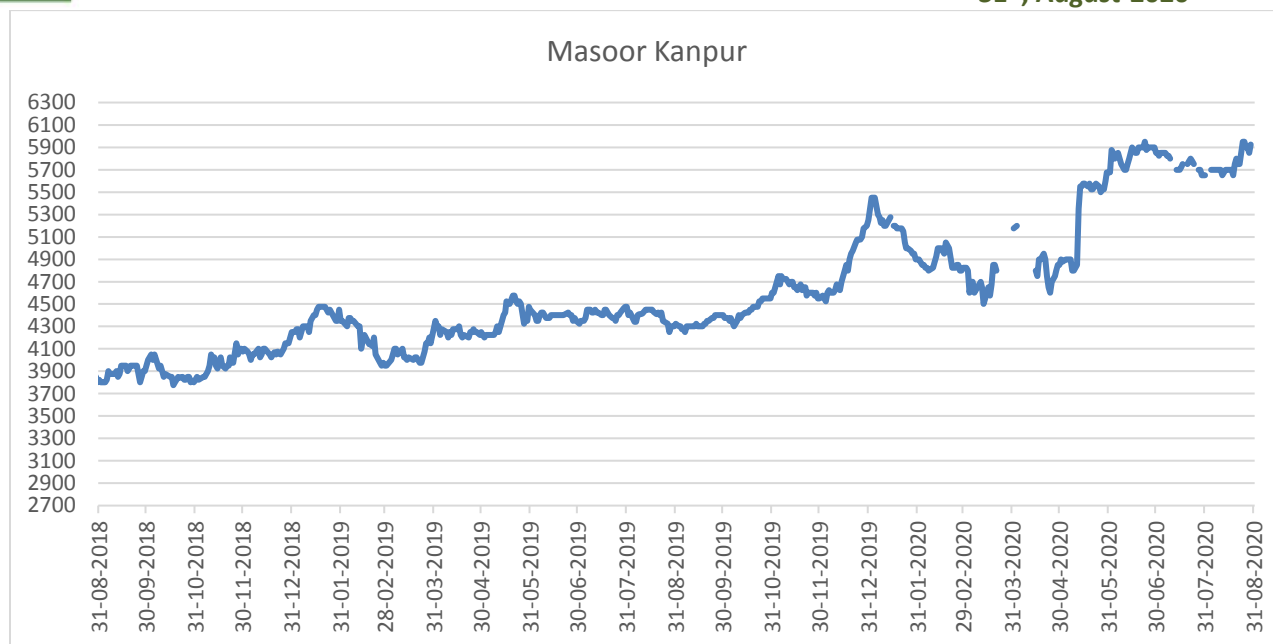
Lentils (Masoor):

Market Recap:

Increasing import flow of masur from Canada and Australia may put pressure on cash masur market. In July and Aug around 4.0 lakh Mt was expected to hit Indian ports. Govt.'s decision is awaited on import time line. Out of this 1.67 lakh Mt has been imported in July. It is going to impact price directly. One vessel having 57400 Mt masur landed at Mundra ports on 4th August and three more vessels having 2 lakh Mt are expected by the end of this month. Its impact is being seen on masur price in domestic market. If prices decrease below Rs 5000, govt would not extend lower duty time line beyond August-2020. In that case, some recovery is expected again in masur market. So it would be interesting to see the govt's action in the last week of August. It would decide the future trend of price. Notably, govt. had slashed the import duty on masur from effective 30 % to 10 % till 31st August-2020 to cool down prices in domestic market on the beginning of June. Stockists are holding stock and waiting for govt.'s decision. There is a rumour in the market that govt would not extend import time line with slashed duty.

Current Scenario:

Stock at ports has started increasing now. At Mumbai ports importers are selling masur at Rs 5300-5350. As prices are ruling higher than MSP in domestic market, govt.s agencies are unable to procure 1.21 lakh MT, set target for the year. As of now, only 4200 Mt has been procured on MSP (Rs4800). Old stock with Nafed is around 21,000 MT. future course of price depends on govt's decision on import timeline with reduced duty or with previous duty, applicable 30% after August.



Market Outlook: Prices may trade lower due to higher supply prospects from import in coming weeks. Sluggish demand from mills and commencement of offloading by stockists remains unsupportive to cash market in the medium term. However, decision on timeline for import on reduced duty is very crucial for the future course of price direction. Nafed may start selling old crop too. It has 21,000 MT old stock. Import is likely to continue at 10% duty till August..Overall tone in masur market remains weak in August. Decision is awaited on duty and import time line.

Pigeon Pea (Tur/Toor):

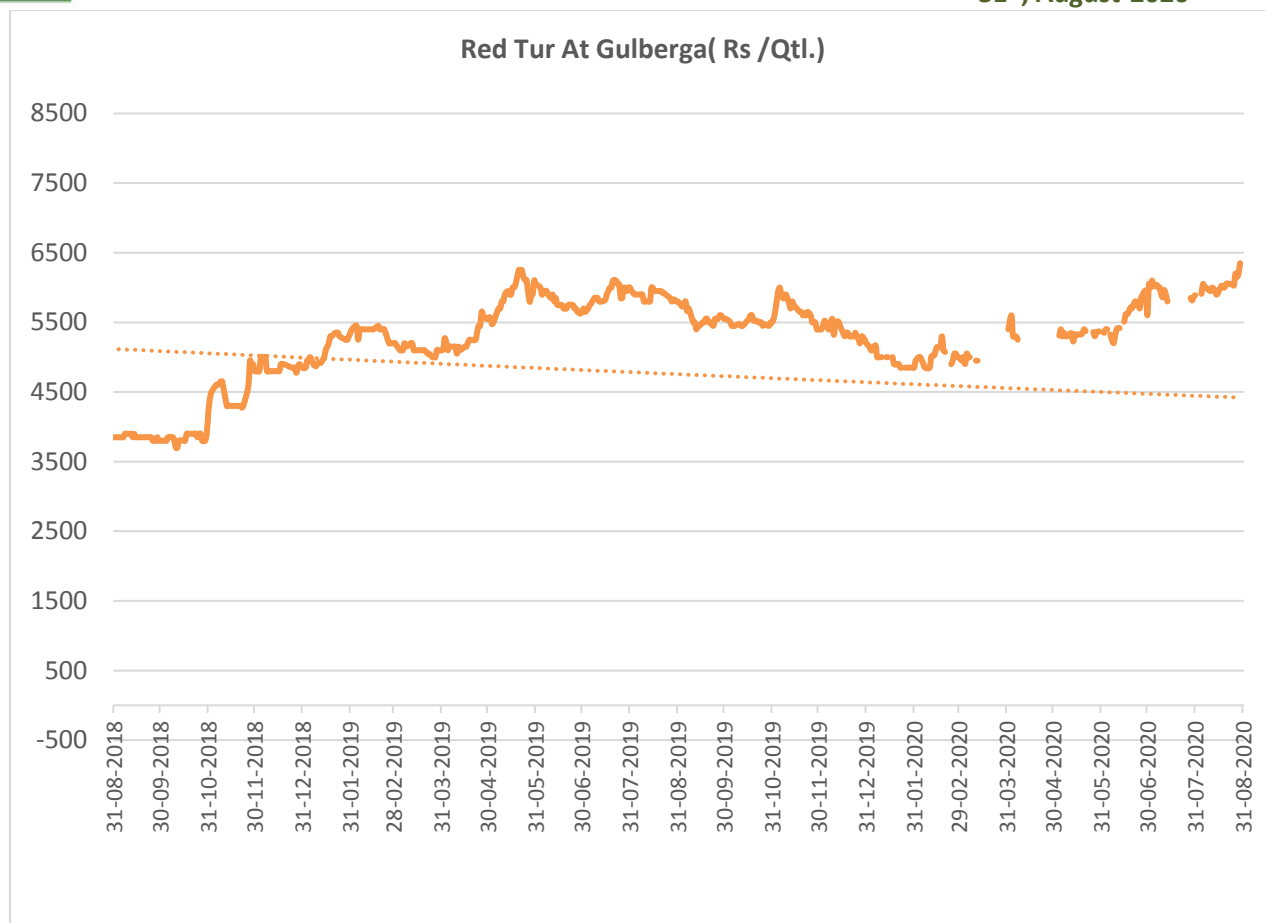
Market Recap:

Stock at port is said to be lower than normal at this point of time. Import licenses have not been given to importers as yet, so millers are buying tur from local markets. Arrivals in local market are decreasing so market is moving up slowly. Relaxation from lock down in various states has increased demand for dal and millers have increased buying. Tur was quoted at Rs5600-5650 in Mumbai market. Tur is being traded at Rs 6000-6150 in Gulberga market. Overall sentiment seems firm. As importers may start buying in Myanmar, tur price has moved up there at \$ 665 per MT basis Indian ports for new crop and \$645 per MT for old crop. Tur price may move further up by Rs100- from current levels. Right now, in Gulberga market it is trading at Rs 6000-6150.

Current Market Dynamics & Outlook:

The production share of tur in total kharif pulses production is 34.5 % and farmers have covered around 98 % (43.63 lakh ha) area of normal (44.29 lakh ha). Planting has entered in last phase now. Agriwatch's preliminary production estimate for 2020-21 is over 1 lakh MT higher at 38.39 lakh MT. It was 37.19 lakh MT in 2019-20. Production may increase more if area continues to move up and weather remains favourable throughout the growing season. As of now crop condition is normal to good. Demand and supply side seems balanced right now.





In the fifth week of Aug-2020, average price in Gulberga market was up by Rs 100 to Rs 6100-6200 due to slower pace of import, improvement in demand for the new crop and improved buying by private traders. However, increasing kharif area and likely selling by Nafed may cap upward momentum in coming weeks. Import volumes (G to G basis) are likely to increase in Aug, while import license can be issued soon for private millers. Tur price is likely to trade firm..

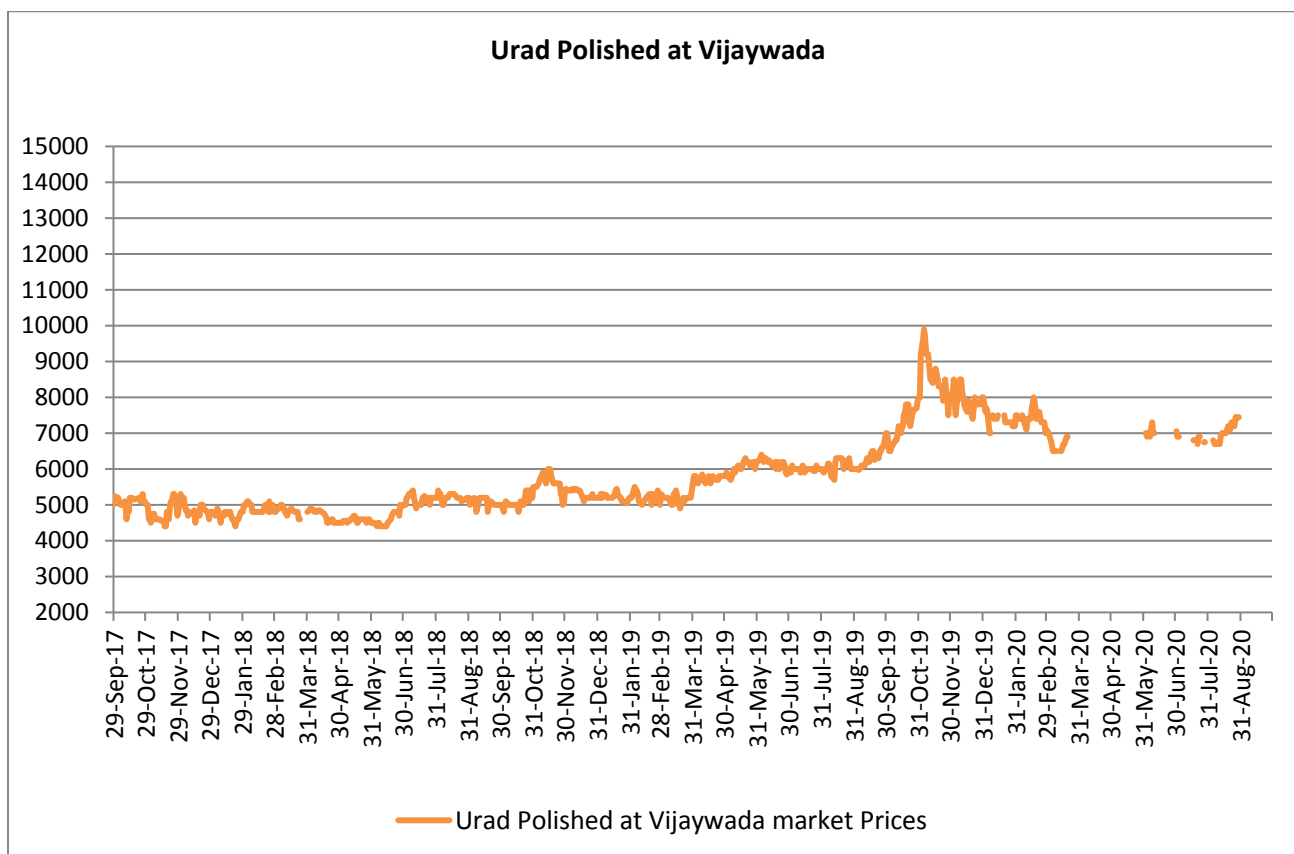
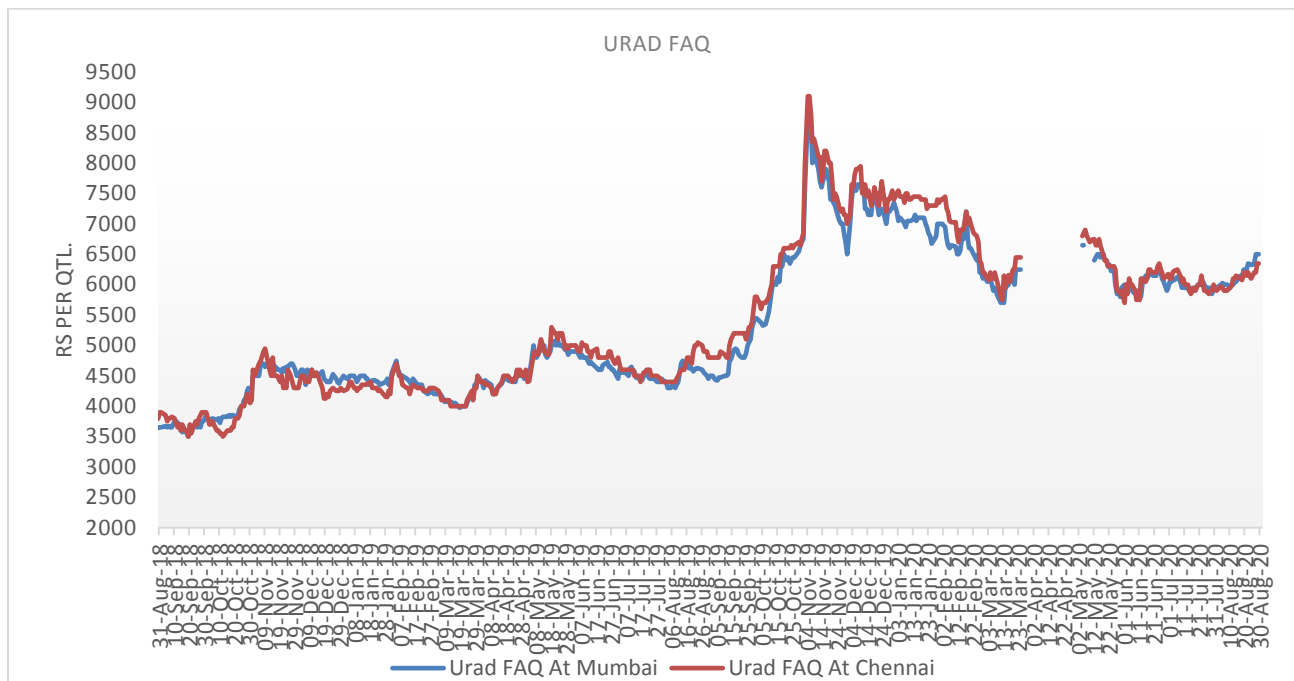
Black Matpe (Urad):

Possibility of higher import in Aug (around 1.5 lakh Mt), higher area coverage, good crop condition and new arrival expected by the end of this month would continue to pressurize urad cash market in coming months. The DGFT had decreased the time line for 4 lakh MT urad import quota from 31st March-2021 to 31August-2020. It would impact market sentiments and urad price may decrease by Rs200-300 from current level. Current firmness would not sustain as arrival from new crop is expected by the end of this month. Demand is normal and mills are waiting for imported urad that are comparatively lower by Rs300-400 per qtl. from local crop. Allocated four lakhMT import is not possible under stipulated time line.Request has been made to increase time line for import by millers.But, extention seems impractical as new arrival is about to begin from kharif crop.There is no report of any major loss due to rains/flooding so far However, if rains continues,quality issue may surface and it would affect price of quality crop.

Current Market Dynamics & Outlook:

Supply side should be adequate in coming weeks. Urad in Mumbai market is being traded at Rs 6250-6350 and may increase to Rs 6400-6450.In Chennai market it is being offered at Rs 6300-6400 and SQ at Rs6800-6900 per qtl. Overall trend remains firm in the short term.

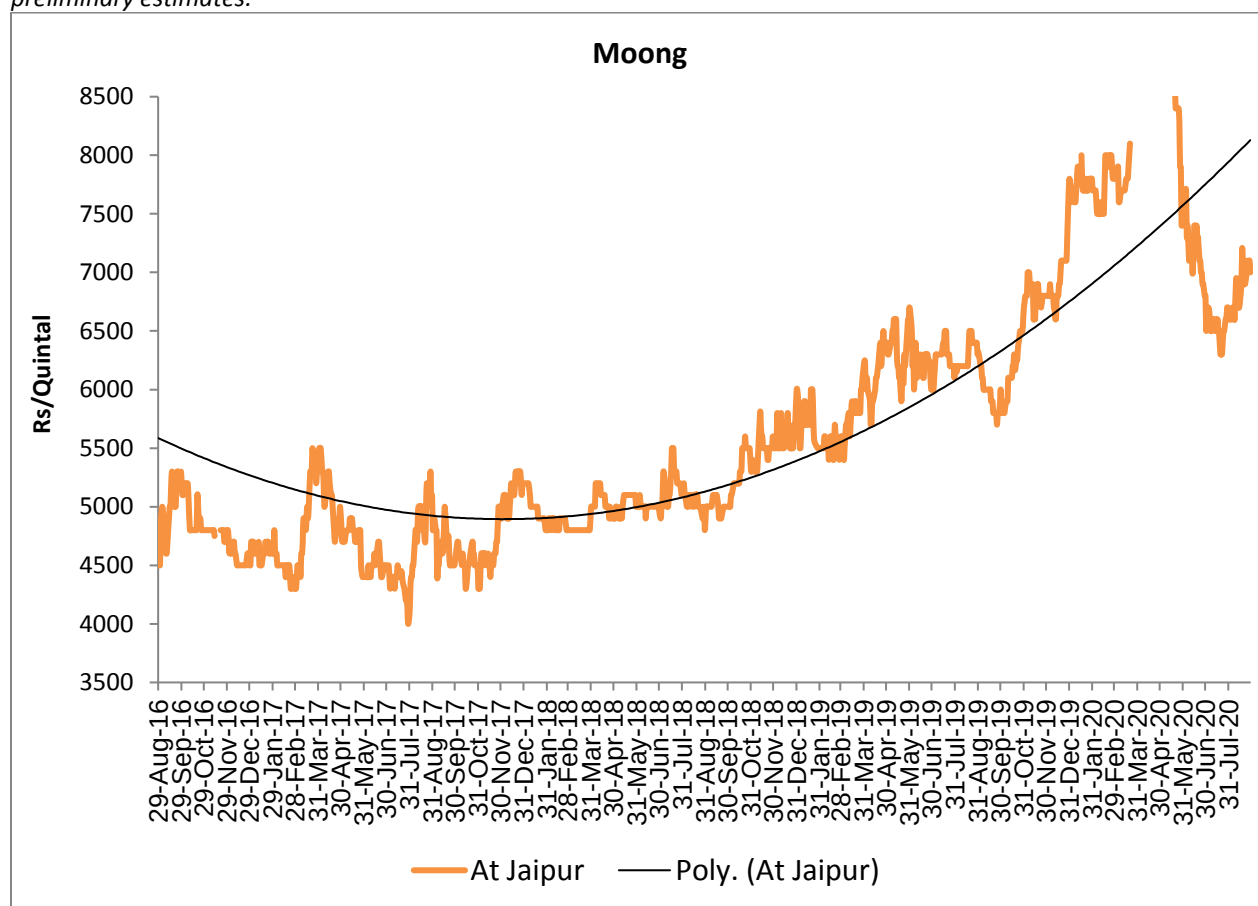

Green Gram (Moong):
Market Recap:

Arrival of summer moong is over now and new arrival from kharif in Karnataka has started now. Stockists have started buying moong at decreased prices and it has helped market to recover again. New Kharif crop in Karnataka began arriving in higher quantities. There is a report of quality loss in some areas of Karnataka due to heavy rains. It would depress prices for quality moong, should quality of moong get affected in other states too. There is no scope for import as prices in Myanmar are ruling higher at this point of time. Moong (FAQ) is being traded at Rs 6100-6900 in Indian market. It may stay steady until arrival from kharif crop increase from other states too.

Apart from this, kharif moong area has crossed 34.85 lakh ha against normal of 30.49 lakh ha. Before this, maximum area was covered in 2016-17, when over 35 lakh ha was sown. Weather conditions are favourable for moong crop in all states except Karnataka and Telangana. Since the proposed MSP of moong is higher at Rs 7196 for 2020-21 against Rs 7050 for ongoing season, it would encourage farmers to cover more area under rabi moong too. Planting has reached at final phase now. Under normal conditions, Agriwatch expects 15.25 to 15.50 lakh MT kharif production as per preliminary estimates.



Market Outlook: Moong prices are likely to trade steady to slightly weak in the near term.
