# **Cotton Domestic Fundamentals:**

- Cotton prices remained steady to firm on Saturday with Abohar and Muktsar end in the green, Amravati, Ahmedabad and Kadi ending steady.
- However millers demand remained lower and may decline further.
- Separately, cotton ginners of Gujarat will continue their six-day-old strike till the Centre takes a positive stand on their demand to lift the ban on cotton exports.
- However reports have started to flow in about crop wilting in Punjab due to extreme heat conditions.

# **Cotton International Fundamentals:**

- U.S cotton markets sentiments remained weak amid signs that global demand is shrinking.
- USDA data showed about 30,500 bales of cotton sales for delivery before July 31<sup>st</sup> were scrapped in the week ended May 12<sup>th</sup>.

# Outlook:

- In the short term, cotton prices may remain steady amid lower activity from millers and traders.
- Cotton futures may trade range to weak on higher plantings in the U.S and weak demand.
- In the long term price trend may depend on global planting in U.S and India and demand from China.
