

Cotton-Daily-Fundamental-Report

May 21, 2011

Cotton Domestic Fundamentals:

- Cotton prices remained mixed on Saturday with Abohar end in the green and Muktsar ending in the red, Amravati, Ahmedabad and Kadi ending steady.
- Sources said on Saturday that gave an assurance to a delegation of Gujarat Congress that the Union ministry may increase the export quota to 1.5 million bales.
- Sources added that demand may improve and this may push markets higher in the short term.
- Area under cotton to increase to 5.70 lakh hectares this season, 87,000 hectares more than what it was during the last season.
- Production is expected to increase 20% this season with an output of 21.80 lakh bales.

Cotton International Fundamentals:

- U.S cotton markets sentiments remained weak amid signs that global demand is shrinking.
- USDA data showed about 30,500 bales of cotton sales for delivery before July 31st were scrapped in the week ended May 12th.

Outlook:

- In the short term, cotton prices may remain steady amid lower activity from millers and traders.
- Cotton futures may trade range to weak on higher plantings in the U.S and weak demand.
- In the long term price trend may depend on global planting in U.S and India and demand from China.
