#### **Cotton Domestic Fundamentals:**

- Cotton prices remained mixed on Thursday with Kadi ending higher, Abohar ending in the red and Amravati and Muktsar ending steady.
- Sentiments may remain weak as cotton acreage in India may improve as India may get early monsoons, supporting crop sowing.
- The Government has taken a decision to allow exports of an additional 10 lakh bales of cotton during the current season ending September.
- Initially, the government had restricted the export cap to 55 lakh bales for 2010-11 which now total to 65 lakh bales.
- This may push the prices up in the short term.

### **Cotton International Fundamentals:**

- U.S cotton futures surged higher after USDA cuts in its 2011/12 cotton production estimate.
- USDA said that the drought conditions in the U.S reduced the outlook for 2011-12 U.S. cotton output to 17 million (480-lb) bales from the 18 million bales forecast last month.
