#### **Domestic Fundamentals:**

- Mostly weak sentiments witnessed in pulses.
- Prices of imported urad have reduced sharply by 4.73% in Chennai market during last week compared to the previous week due to lack of buying interest but dull demand in international market reduced C&F prices of urad by 5.4% during the same period and this has converted parity in imports into disparity.
- Since farmers are still holding stock of tur in Karnataka and recent gain in tur prices due to delayed sowing has increased the arrivals of the commodity in Gulbarga market and this has erased gains of past few days in tur prices.
- Lack of fresh buying enquiries for masoor at higher levels moved masoor prices into southwards direction in Kanpur market.
- Firm demand for peas amid worries of supply shortage in domestic markets in coming months has resulted into steady movement in peas prices and this is also restricting major downfall in chana prices. However, 55,666 tonnes of peas are expected arrive at Mumbai port in next couple of days and this might check peas prices for short term.

#### **International Fundamentals:**

- Dull demand for pulses in international market has reduced prices of Burmese tur and urad and it is further expected to remain on lower side in near term.
- Pulses crop in Saskatchewan is reported in fair to good condition in most of the regions. However, weather and field conditions continue to be very challenging in some of the regions.
- As per the latest report released by Government of Saskatchewan, around 82% of the crop (all crops including pulses) has been seeded in the state till June 13, 2011 compared to the last year's seeded area of 73% during the same period.

#### **Market News:**

#### Pulses area increased to 2.86 lakh hectares

As per latest reports received from different States, sowing of kharif crops is progressing well. Rice has been sown in 10.35 lakh hectare till date as compared to 10.32 lakh hectare of last year's acreage.

Pulses have been sown in 2.86 lakh hectare so far, which is more than 5 thousand hectare over the last year's acreage. Area under oilseeds till date is 3.47 lakh hectares marking an increase of 47 thousand hectare.

Sugarcane has been planted in 50.94 lakh hectare, which is 2.23 lakh hectares more than last year's coverage on this date.

Cotton has been sown in 21.65 lakh hectare as compared to 15.42 lakh hectare last year. It represents an increase of 6.23 lakh hectare over the last year's acreage.

Sowing of Jute and Mesta is also in progress. 8.47 lakh hectares has been covered under the cultivation of jute and Mesta till date as compared to 7.78 lakh hectare last year. (Source: PIB)

### Pulses Import Declined During 2010-11

Normal monsoon during last year (2010-11) improved pulses production in the country and subsequently reduced India's dependence on import of pulses.

As per the latest report released by Ministry of Commerce, import of peas during Apr 10-Feb 11 was recorded at 13.63 lakh tonnes compared to the previous year's import of 15.46 lakh tonnes during the same period.

In case of urad & moong, around 4.27 lakh tonnes quantity is imported during Apr 10-Feb 11 against 6.38 lakh tonnes of previous year's import.

While 0.97 lakh tonnes of chickpeas, 1.58 lakh tonnes of masoor and 2.95 lakh tonnes of tur is imported during Apr 10-Feb 11 against last year's import figures of 3.26 lakh tonnes, 2.49 lakh tonnes and 3.54 lakh tonnes respectively.
