

#### **Cotton Domestic Fundamentals:**

- Cotton prices remained steady to firm on Wednesday at major trading centers.
- Prices moved higher as Directorate-General of Foreign Trade (DGFT) have opened registration for allowing export of additional 10 lakh bales.
- However area under cotton has increased by 40.4% compared to last year's area.
- Cotton has been sown in 21.65 lakh hectare as compared to 15.42 lakh hectare last year.
- Sentiments were weak as India's cotton yarn exports declined 33 per cent in the first two months of the current financial year, due to low demand.
- The shipment is estimated at 100-110 million kg, as against 150-160 million kg in the corresponding period last year.

### **Cotton International Fundamentals:**

- U.S sentiments remained weak as demand from China will be weak.
- According to USDA acreage and production will be lower this year due to after drought in Texas and floods in areas along the Mississippi River damaged crops or delayed plantings.

#### **Outlook: Domestic and International**

- In the short term, domestic cotton prices move higher on better export demand in the markets.
- In the long run, prices may trade weak due to higher acreage estimates and weak yarn exports.
- U.S Cotton futures may trade lower on lower Chinese demand.
- In the long run, prices may trade higher due to lower U.S crop anticipations.
