November 12<sup>th</sup>, 2011

### **Cotton Domestic Fundamentals:**

Cotton prices remained firm on Friday as buying activity remained improved at lows amid lower arrivals. Weather will assist harvest in all states. Picking has started in all major states like Gujarat, Rajasthan, A.P, Haryana and Punjab. Meanwhile, USDA said in its report that output is expected to increase to 27.5 million bales, from 25.4 million bales the previous season. Meanwhile Cotton Advisory Board (CAB) said that despite bad weather cotton output is likely to remain higher at 35.5 million bales (of 170 kg each). CAB will meet on November 15<sup>th</sup> 2011 to assess position following reports of output loss in many areas and higher output in others. Acreage is also expected to increase to 12.2 million hectares in the current season as against 11.1 million hectares last season.

### **Cotton International Fundamentals**

Cotton futures moved higher after USDA lowered its forecast for the U.S. cotton harvest. Markets also fell after data showed Chinese cotton imports surged last month. USDA lower the crop estimates to 16.3 billion bales, down 2% from last month's forecast and 10% below year-ago levels. However, exports were also lowered to 12 million bales from 13 million bales on reduced demand for the fiber. Global production is expected to higher at 123.4 million bales due to higher output from China, India and Pakistan. China's imports surged by 28.7% in October from September due to increased demand for the fiber. USDA said in its report that China bought 998,000 running bales (RBs, 500-lbs each). The December contract finished higher by 2.4% to end at 99.50 cents per lb.

### **Outlook: Domestic and International**

In the short term, domestic cotton prices move lower on higher production estimates, weak demand and fresh arrival expectations.

U.S markets may trade range bound to firm on lower US harvest and higher Chinese demand.
