Cotton Domestic Fundamentals:

Cotton prices remained mixed with Abohar and Punjab ending higher and remaining centers ending on the lower side. Weather will assist harvest in all states. Picking has started in all major states like Gujarat, Rajasthan, A.P, Haryana and Punjab. Meanwhile, USDA said in its report that output is expected to increase to 27.5 million bales, from 25.4 million bales the previous season. Prices may continue the current downtrend as millers may want to buy at lower levels. Export demand remains firm, however may continue weaken at higher levels and may pressurize prices to weaken further. Total arrival in the country was 130,000 bales and may increase further and may also pull prices lower.

Cotton International Fundamentals

Cotton futures moved higher after USDA lowered its forecast for the U.S. cotton harvest. Markets also fell after data showed Chinese cotton imports surged last month. USDA lower the crop estimates to 16.3 billion bales, down 2% from last month's forecast and 10% below year-ago levels. However, exports were also lowered to 12 million bales from 13 million bales on reduced demand for the fiber. Global production is expected to higher at 123.4 million bales due to higher output from China, India and Pakistan. China's imports surged by 28.7% in October from September due to increased demand for the fiber. USDA said in its report that China bought 998,000 running bales (RBs, 500-lbs each). Markets remained weak at higher prices as China's cotton output this year is expected to increase 21% to 7.55 million metric tons. Acreage rose 8.5% from a year earlier to 5.3 million hectares, while unit yield increased 11.6% to 1.43 tons a hectare.

Outlook: Domestic and International

In the short term, domestic cotton prices move lower on higher production estimates, weak demand and fresh arrival expectations.
