

# **Cotton-Daily-Fundamental-Report**

November 17<sup>th</sup>, 2011

### **Cotton Domestic Fundamentals:**

Cotton prices traded on Wednesday trade as arrivals declined in key markets. Weather will assist harvest in all northern states. However rains in Tamil Nadu may hinder crop pickings. Crop picking has started in all major states like Gujarat, Rajasthan, A.P, Haryana and Punjab with a delay in Tamil Nadu due to rains. Demand remained slightly better on limited availability of ready stocks. Exporters also remained active and may continue to buy. Arrivals declined as farmers are holding onto stocks in anticipation of better returns. Total arrival in the country was 115,000 bales. Meanwhile, a delegation, headed by Maharashtra Chief Minister Prithviraj Chavan, will meet Prime Minister Manmohan Singh to discuss the demand for increase in minimum support price for cotton soon.

#### **Cotton International Fundamentals**

Cotton futures end higher on investor buying and higher imports from China. March cotton futures went up the 4.00 cents daily limit, or 4%, to settle at \$1.0062 a lb. Markets were supported by reports of higher imports from China as National Cotton Reserves Corporation reported that China imported 252,300 tonnes of cotton in October, a 163% jump from the same period last year. The imports were higher as cotton prices were lower last year. However, gains may be restricted as USDA reported in its weekly crop progress report that nearly 79% of the U.S. cotton crop was harvested as of November 13, up from 70% the week before. Meanwhile, in Pakistan buying was seen from exporters, millers and spinners. Traders reported that ginners have a huge amount of unsold stock are likely release that stock due to fresh arrivals in their local markets. This may restrict upside. Australian cotton output may increase by 25% to 5 million bales in 2011-12 compared to 4 million bales in the previous year.

## **Outlook: Domestic and International**

In the short term, domestic cotton prices move higher firm demand and decline in arrivals.

U.S markets may trade range bound to weak on weak Chinese demand and higher global crop.
