### **Cotton Domestic Fundamentals:**

Steady to Weak sentiments were reported on Tuesday in key trading centers. Activity from spinners and improved at lower levels and may restrict downside. Demand for Yan also improved at lower levels. Millers may start to buy as current prices are in line for better margins. Exporters were also buying as fresh export inquiries were seen at 90 cent per pound. Total arrival in the country was 125,000 bales compared to 140,000-150,000 bales on the previous day. However India's cotton supplies in the peak arrival months of October and November have dropped as farmers are holding out for higher prices. Cotton arrivals between October 1<sup>st</sup> and November 20<sup>th</sup> fell more than 25% from a year earlier to 3.5 million bales of 170 kilograms (375 pounds) each, according to Cotton Corporation of India.

### **Cotton International Fundamentals**

Cotton futures ended higher on Monday. Outside market strength is supporting cotton trade. Futures were supported by weak the dollar index. Small investors were buying amid optimism on the Eurozone crisis. The March cotton futures rose 0.48 cent to end at 91.35 cents per lb. Cotton futures was also supported by buying activity from China. USDA weekly data showed that US weekly export sales report said China has bought over 2.3 million running bales (a bale=500 lbs). Meanwhile, Pakistan cotton production could be estimated around 13.5 million bales in 2011-12 against 11.6 million bales produced last season.

### **Outlook: Domestic and International**

In the short term, domestic cotton prices move range bound to weak on anticipation of peak arrival season and weak demand.

U.S markets may trade range bound to weak on lower demand from textiles and higher year-on-year harvests.
