Cotton Domestic Fundamentals:

Market sentiments remained mixed with Abohar and Muktsar ending lower firm, Amravati, Kadi and Ahmedabad remaining steady to firm on Wednesday's trade. Cotton Corporation of India say that arrivals till date has been lower at 52.24 lakh bales compared to 69.46 lakh bales in the previous season. Arrivals declined due to delayed sowings due to prolonged rains. Arrivals also declined as producers are holding back the fiber demanding higher state-assured prices. The exporters are active in the market and as the Indian rupee is above Rs.50 for the US dollar sources say that exporters will remain active. However, millers are only buying cotton to cover for their immediate requirement. Meanwhile, weak demand in domestic as well as international markets has caused ginners to run their factories on a limited time and the ginning activity is currently below 40-45% due to slow arrivals and lower sales.

Cotton International Fundamentals

Cotton futures end higher on Tuesday as the market awaited Friday's release of a government crop report. Key March cotton futures gained 1.59 cent to finish at 93.81 cents per lb. Markets moved higher as ICAC reduced its outlook for 2012-13. Sowing of the fibre for next season's harvests will tumble 8% to 33.3 million hectares as a more than halving in cotton prices from a record high as prices are lower and may encourages growers to switch to other crops. Production will decline in 2012-13. This may increase exports given an expectation that production will fall most notably in importing nations. Meanwhile, Pakistan's cotton production is expected to increase by 15.47% over the last year. Sources added that the country has harvested around 1.293 million more bales over the corresponding period last year. This might keep the prices weak.

Outlook: Domestic and International

In the short term, domestic cotton prices move range bound on weak demand from ginners.
