

Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

- Wheat cash market remained steady on back of better demand and decreased arrivals from private stock. Prices are likely to stay firm in current week. Offtake from govt. stock is likely to increase.
- Wheat has been shown in 76.67 lakh hectare against 85.92 lakh hectare last year on this date. Area coverage of wheat compared to last year is less due to mainly late harvesting of kharif paddy crop. Due to delayed harvesting of paddy wheat sowing is lagging behind.
- **Combined wheat and rice stocks in central pool** registered at 557.54 lakh tonnes as on 01.11.2011.Wheat stock registered at 296.71 lakh tonnes.

Wheat International Fundamental:

- Egypt, the world's biggest wheat importer, agreed to buy 240,000 tonnes of milling wheat at a tender today, Nomani Nomani, vice chairman of the General Authority for Supply Commodities. Deal was finalized at \$249 per T.
- The federal government decided to increase the wheat's support price to Rs. 1150 from 950 per 40 kg, media reported Saturday. Farmers seemed satisfied with the decision
- **Bangladesh's state grains buyer will defer the process** of a tender to buy 50,000 tonnes of wheat by two weeks due to storage constraints. The new date for the opening of bids will be Dec. 5 instead of Nov. 21
