

Wheat Domestic Fundamentals:

- Most of the spot market of Wheat traded flat barring Delhi and Madhya Pradesh, which closed slightly up almost gaining by 5 Rs. and 10 Rs. respectively due to dull trade activities. Additionally, higher coverage area added bearishness further in the market.
- Offtake is likely to remain at higher side as stocks in private hand is decreasing fast. And millers are relying almost on government stocks.
- **Weather remains favorable** falling temperature at night and recent rains in some growing areas are considered to be beneficial for Wheat crop which under tillering stage.
- Latest wheat sowing status is expected early in the next week however almost 85% sowing has been completed so far.

Wheat International Fundamental:

- CBOT wheat futures ended mostly higher on support from other grains and short-covering. The grains complex was lifted higher by soybeans, which rallied on dry South American weather. Although traders mostly worried about soybeans, some say the weather poses problems for wheat and corn production also.
- Argentina's agriculture ministry sharply trimmed its forecast for 2011-12 wheat production, pegging the crop at 12 million metric tons compared to its earlier estimate of 13.5 million tonnes.

Outlook: Domestic market:

• Wheat cash and future market is expected to trade weak in next trading session.
