


Onion Fundamentals:

- Arrivals are good in major mandis of Maharashtra. Prices are depressed due to fear of increased arrivals in the month of April. As per a trade source, situation will be clearer once the peak arrival time starts.
- There is no stocking interest for red variety onion. Traders are waiting for pink variety (gerwa) which will start from the month of April. Export activity will gather pace once good quality arrivals start.
- Normal demand is seen from other parts of the country.
- As per traders, prices are expected to be range bound for some time as there is regular demand from Punjab, Karnataka and West Bengal and good supply from the producing regions.
- At the same time, the retail prices in India are hovering between Rs. 500 to Rs 1400/Qtl. The highest retail price of Rs. 1400/Qtl was recorded in Delhi and Shimla.

Outlook:

Onion price is likely to stay range bound in the near future with a slight downward bias due to ensuing peak arrival season in Maharashtra and Karnataka from April onwards. But major dip is not expected as other vegetables price are ruling high and Govt's MEP will provide cushion to prices.

Today prices in Bangalore Mandi is down by around Rs. 100/Qtl due to heavy arrivals as compared to 9th March. During last one week average arrivals were in the range to 15000-2000 Qtl. Today arrivals were recorded near 32000 qtl after two consecutive holidays and average prices recorded was Rs. 458/Qtl.
