

Onion Fundamentals:

- Onion Prices in Delhi and Mumbai are more or less stable with some downward bias due to higher arrivals from producing regions.
- Arrivals have increased in Lasalgaon Mandi of Nashik. Average arrivals per day in last four days are above 15000 qtl.
- Prices have not fallen much due to regular domestic and export demand for Rabi onion.
- The Center is expected to take some decision on Onion exports in its high-level meeting on April 30.
- Export demand for Rabi onion is coming from Dubai, Colombo, Bangladesh and European countries.
- The onion prices would find support due to its availability at cheaper rates when compared to other vegetables.
- Meanwhile, retail prices are hovering in between Rs. 500-1500/Qtl. The lowest prices of Rs. 500/Qtl were recorded in Bhopal district of Madhya Pradesh.


Onion Prices & Arrivals in Producing & Consumption Centers
