





## Onion Fundamentals:

- The Commerce Ministry is in favor of removing the minimum export price (MEP) on onions for two months to boost exports and ensure better returns to farmers.
- At present, MEP for onion stands at \$125/Ton FOB and was revised from \$150/Ton in the month of Feb 2012 looking at bumper late khariff arrivals.
- In Lasalgaon, large chunk of onion arrivals are going into store as stockiest feels prices to be lucrative. Traders expect Rabi onions which are available currently in the range of Rs 250-350/Qtl in various Maharashtra APMCs could fetch around Rs. 400-500/Qtl in Lean season.
- In Bangalore, arrivals of local onion have increased in last 2-3 days, however prices are more or less stable near 625/Qtl.
- Export demand for Rabi onion is coming from Dubai, Colombo, Bangladesh and European countries.
- Meanwhile, retail prices are hovering in between Rs. 500-1500/Qtl. The highest prices of Rs. 1500/Qtl was recorded in Shimla.
- As per traders, Onion prices are likely to be range bound due to higher arrivals in producing region and regular domestic and export demand. The stocking interest for Rabi crop from both farmers and traders also give support to prices from any sharp fall.
