



#### **Onion Fundamentals:**


- Storage activity has gather pace after abolishment of MEP on Onion. Prices have not fallen much despite increase in arrivals in major Mandis of Maharashtra.
- The Govt had scrapped the Minimum Export Price (MEP) on 2<sup>nd</sup> May for two months. MEP prior to this decision on Onion was \$125/Ton FOB.
- Local arrivals in Orissa, Haryana, Himachal Pradesh has increased in their local mandi.
- Traders expect price could increase Rs 50-100/Qtl in short term due to removal of MEP in near term and give competitive edge against China and Pakistan in International trade of Onion.
- Meanwhile, retail prices are hovering in between Rs. 500-1500/Qtl. The highest prices of Rs. 1500/Qtl was recorded in Shimla, Trivendrum and Srinagar.

## Outlook:

Prices are likely to be range bound with upward bias in short term due to storage demand from stockiest and higher consumption demand ahead in summers. However, major increase in prices is unlikely as growers will keep supplying onion in Mandi due to higher production in last Rabi season.
