

Onion Fundamentals:


- Onion arrivals have increased in Lasalgaon and Pimplagaon Mandi of Nashik districts. Average arrivals have increased to 1200-1500 trolys of 2-2.5 MT each from 500-600 trolys.
- Traders and Exporters are taking active participation in auction after removal of MEP for two months.
- As per news reports, farmers in Nasik districts demanding further Market Intervention Scheme and Minimum Support Price (MSP) for Onions.
- Storage activity has gathered pace in Maharashtra as rabi crop can be stored for 6-7 months and has good export demand.
- Traders expect price could increase Rs 50-100/Qtl in short term due to removal of MEP in near term and give competitive edge against China and Pakistan in International trade of Onion.
- Meanwhile, retail prices are hovering in between Rs. 500-1500/Qtl. The highest prices of Rs. 1500/Qtl was recorded in Shimla, Trivendrum and Srinagar.


Onion Prices & Arrivals in Producing & Consumption Centers

Outlook:

Prices are likely to increase in short term as storing activity has geared up after abolishment of MEP. However, major increase in prices is unlikely as growers will keep supplying onion in Mandi due to higher production in last Rabi season.
