



## **Onion Fundamentals:**


- Average arrivals in Lasalgaon and Pimplagaon hovering between 25000-30000 quintals daily. It had reached to 40000-50000 quintals in last week.
- Farmers are bringing their produce in large quantity due to rainy days ahead in Maharashtra. Rain could damage the quality of onion and also reduce the weight due to de-hydration as informed by one of the Exporter in Lasalgaon.
- Traders expect price could increase in coming days as supply decrease because of rain in Maharashtra.
- At present, export prices are ranging between \$140-160/Ton FOB based on quality of onion.
- Meanwhile, retail prices are hovering in between Rs. 400-1500/Qtl. The lowest price of Rs. 400/Qtl was recorded in Bhopal due higher local arrivals and from Maharashtra in their mandis
