
## **Onion Fundamentals:**

- From the price and arrival graph of the Pimplagaon market we can see decline in arrivals and prices have increased because farmers have stocked the onion whereas demand is high in market
- In Bhavnagar market supply is low and mostly the onion is coming from local regions only. Farmers have stored the onion in a hope that in future the prices will rise but as per the trader prices may fall in future because all of a sudden there will be a huge supply in the market.
- As per the trader in Bihar the prices of onion are expected to increase from next month onward as the season of marriages will be there and people are not left with many vegetable choices.
- In Indore market last one week chart depicts that prices have fallen due to sustained supply from Nashik region and local arrivals.
