
# Market Intelligence System

#### **Onion Fundamentals:**

- In Delhi onion is coming from Rajasthan, which is of red dark red colour. Onion from Rajasthan has less shelf life as compare to other region onions.
- In last few days prices of onion in Delhi market have shown continuous rise, which are moving at an average Rs6/kg. The reason behind high prices is that the arrival has fallen.
- Prices of onion are on peak in the month of diwali. After that prices fall because low quality onion is • available in market.
- Onions from Nasik side are fetching highest prices because of high quality and secondly their shelf life is • high.
- In Lasalgaon APMC of Nasik district, daily arrivals have fallen from 20000 Qtl to 17000 Qtl on 6<sup>th</sup> June. In fact in other major mandis like Piplagaon, Indore, Pune, Bangalore and Mumbai arrivals fallen yesterday.
