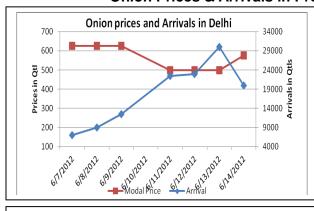
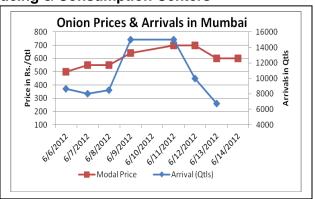
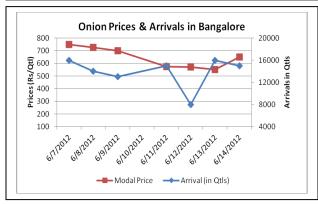
#### **Onion Fundamentals:**

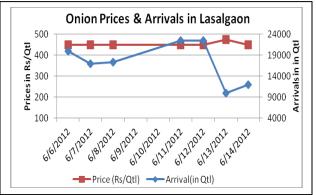
- In Hyderabad 25% of onion is coming from Karnataka where as rest of the onion is coming from Maharashtra region. Onion price in Hyderabad is expected to stay steady to firm on account of lower arrival expectation. Keeping in view the onset of active monsoon during coming couple of weeks stockists are slowly releasing onion stocks to fetch premium during monsoon season.
- Higher onion arrivals could be seen in Delhi mandis on account of release of stocks by the growers. Farmers fear of post harvest losses to their stocked onions in their fields due to excessive heat. This lead to active selling by the growers thereby increasing arrivals.
- Moving forward, we expect arrivals to come down gradually with the onset of rains expected during last week of June to first week of July. The same shall stand supportive for onion prices once active precipitation starts in NW region of India.
- In Delhi small size, dark red colour onion is available which is coming from Jodhpur. It is cheaper Rs2-3/kg as compare to other variety of onion arriving in Azadpur Mandi.
- In Ahmadabad onion is coming from Nasik whereas minimum quantity of local onions is available to
  meet local demand. Local onion was mainly coming from 'Saurashtra' region. Considering relatively
  higher freight charges due to surge in recent diesel prices onion prices in Ahmadabad could surge up
  moving forward.
