


## **Onion Fundamentals:**

- The average prices of onion in Hyderabad in month of May were seen at Rs 731/ which declined by nearly 18% in month of June to Rs 604/ quintal. The decline is mainly attributed to sharp increase in arrivals from Maharashtra and Karnataka..
- Sowing in Karnataka is complete by 5-8% which is lagging y-o-y due to deficit rainfall. Sowing is likely to advance in July which leads to delay in kharif onion sowing by almost 2-3 weeks.
- As per trade sources, sowing just started in Pune while sowing in Nasik will kick off during coming couple of weeks. Any rainfall deficit during 1<sup>st</sup> to 2<sup>nd</sup> week of July as predicted by various meteorological departments of developed nations could delay sowing further.
- In Karnataka local stored onion is arriving in the market which was harvested in the month of April-May. As per the trader both arrival and prices are expected to increase after one month to meet the demand of A.P and west Bengal.
