



# **Onion Fundamentals:**


- 5-8 % of Kharif Onion sowing in Karnataka is complete which is lagging y-o-y due to deficit rainfall. Sowing is delayed by 2-3 weeks and is likely to keep pace in July.
- In Ahmednagar (Maharashtra) sowing has not yet started which was completed by 40% last year at the same time last year. If this condition would remain same then there are chances of its impact on prices.
- The early kharif crop area in Andhra Pradesh is going to be less due to water scarcity in comparison to last year. About 15-20% area has been planted under early kharif and rest will be completed by end of June. The early khariff sowing for A.P and Karnataka is delayed because of delay in arrival of monsoon.
- In Jaipur local produced onion is coming in market and it will be available till Diwali. The average price of onion is Rs 645/ quintal and is expected to go up to Rs. 700/Qtl in few weeks.
- Meanwhile retail prices are hovering in between Rs. 500-1500/Qtl. The highest prices are reported in Srinagar, Shimla, Trivendrum & Gangtok. The retail prices in metro cities are trading between Rs. 1000-1400/Qtl.
