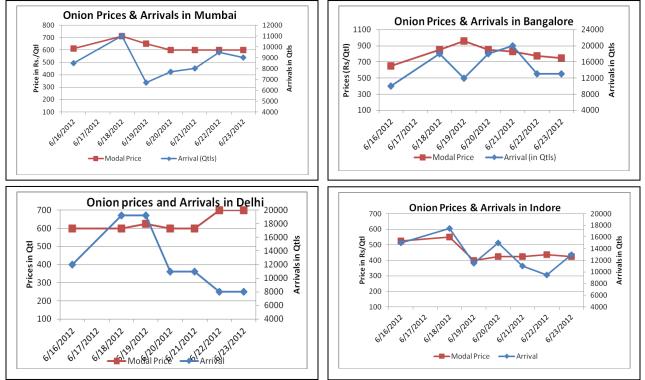

Daily Onion Report 25 June 2012

Onion Fundamentals:

- As per the trader lack of pre monsoon rain in the Nasik region is a reason to worry. This is because Nasik district alone contribute around 40-45% of total onion production in Maharashtra.
- In Delhi market arrival of onion is coming from Maharashtra, Madhya Pradesh and Rajasthan which contribute 40%, 30% and 30% respectively. However supply has reduced these days due to lower supply from producing region as prices have started to increase.
- As per the trader from Piplagaon and Lasalgaon there is a fair demand of onion from Oman, Dubai and Qatar in the Gulf, Sri Lanka and Bangladesh. Farmers are holding back their produce in their storages in seek of higher prices in coming days as increase in demand from other countries.
- At the Lasalgaon market on Saturday, the modal price or the rate at which most trades took place was Rs 550 per quintal with arrivals topping 1700 tons. Prices were Rs 75 high from Friday as arrivals were decreased by 15% in respect to previous day.
