Daily Onion Report 28 June 2012

Onion Fundamentals:

- In Delhi 70% onion is coming from M.P and Rajasthan because their demand is high as compare to Nasik onion whose share is 30% in the total arrival. Prices are hovering between Rs625- Rs700 per quintal. Prices are expected to increase further because of arrival of monsoon.
- In Lasalgaon, arrivals were decreased by 28% as compared to previous day because farmers are still hoarding the onion in seek of higher prices in future because onion of Lasalgaon has more shelf life as compare to other places. Prices are further expected to increase because sowing of Khariff crop has already delayed, so demand for stored onion will be high.
- In Ahmednagar (Maharashtra) arrivals have increased because high quality of onions are fetching 20% more price, earlier for which farmers used to get Rs625/ quintal are now getting Rs 750/quintal.
- In Nasik market prices are firm throughout the month whereas demand from South India has increased, per day 40-50 trucks are supplied to South India region. As per the trader prices will increase after the arrival of monsoon.
