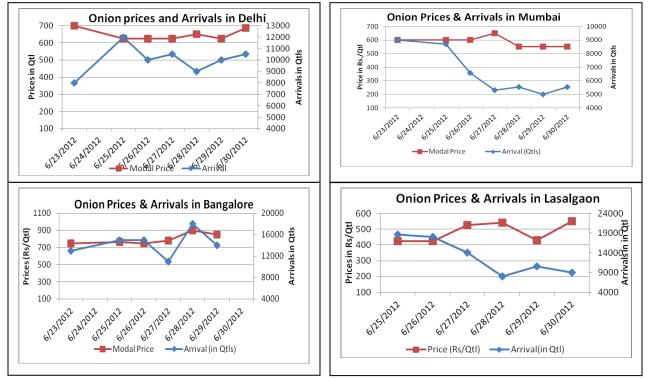

Onion Fundamentals:

- In Delhi among the total arrival, 10% onion is coming from Gujarat and rest is coming from M.P, Maharashtra and Rajasthan. Though the arrival has rise but still the prices have shown an increase of 10% from previous day. The traders are assuming healthy market ahead.
- As per the trader from Nasik onion exports are doing well. Gulf countries and Far East countries are buying. The government on Friday completely liberalised onion exports, allowing shipments without the bar of a minimum export price, a move which would further boost exports of the vegetable.
- In Maharashtra 40% of onion out of the total arrival is coming from Ahmednagar and remaining is contributed by different parts of the region. As per the trader it's not raining out there so this condition is pushing up the prices.
- As per the trader from lasalgaon arrivals are decreasing because onion produced here has a shelf life of five- six months and because of these maximum farmers store their commodities, hoping they would get higher prices. This crop will continue to arrive in market till October.
