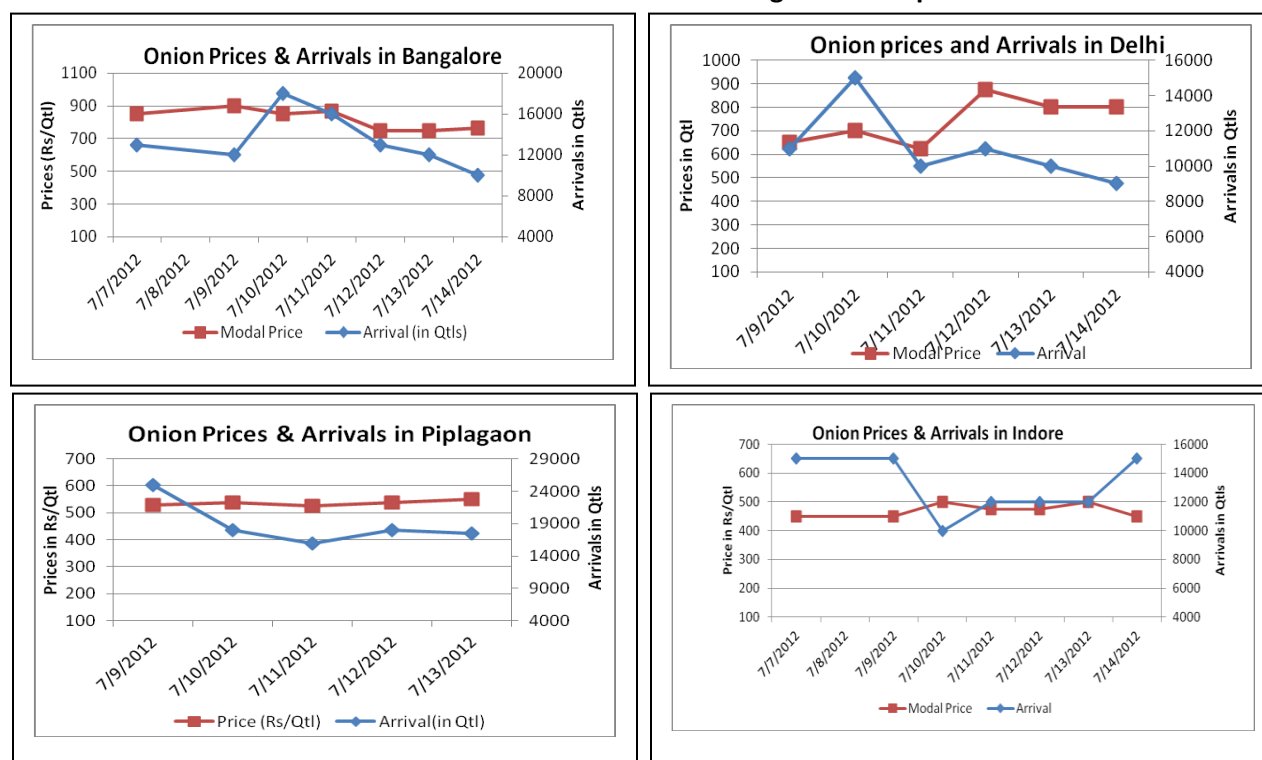


## Onion Fundamentals:

- In major mandis of Maharashtra prices have increased as compare to last week. Poor monsoon coverage in growing areas of Maharashtra has contributed to rising trend in prices. Export demand from West –Asia has picked up which is another reason for increase in prices.
- In Lasalgaon, delay in arrival of monsoon has led to fear that Khariff crop could be delayed and production will be less in this kharif so prices are expected to increase further.
- In Bangalore 15% of onion is coming from local region (Bijapur) whereas 85% is coming from Maharashtra region. As per the trader prices are expected to increase more as this week average prices were Rs 810/quintal.
- 9000 quintal of Onion arrived at Azadpur mandi of Delhi and modal price recorded was Rs. 800/Qtl. Prices have increased in last 3-4 days and further expected to increase due to lower arrivals.
