



Onion Fundamentals:

- Onion prices are likely to rise from current levels of Rs.7-8 per kilo in wholesale market of Delhi, Azadpur to about Rs 15 around September-October. As per traders, last year at this time onions were selling near Rs5-6/Kg in the Azadpur Mandi.
- In Lasalgaon the average arrivals have decreased from 12500 Qtl to 6000 Qtl compared to last week. The reason behind this decline is that farmers/traders have hoard the stock in hope of that next month onward prices may go up. As monsoon has arrived, so the prices are expected to increase due to supply & demand mismatch.
- As per NHB, retail prices of onion are ranging between 900-2000/Qtl in different cities. The highest being recorded in Trivendrum and Srinagar followed by Chandigarh at Rs. 1800/Qtl
