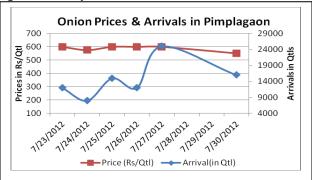
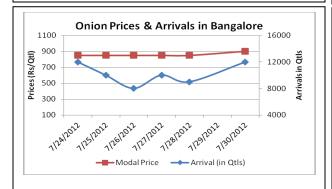
Onion Fundamentals:

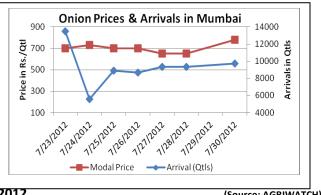
- In Indore market, onion is mainly arriving from local regions. Major demand for Indore side onions is from North India, especially Delhi and U.P. Prices are moving in the range Rs 500/quintal to Rs 600/quintal. As per traders, prices are expected to touch Rs 700/quintal in the next two weeks.
- As per sources in Lasalgaon, farmers are shifting from Onion crop towards soyabean and maize because
 of late arrival of monsoon. The other reason is high realizations in soybean and maize crop as
 compared to onion. This shifting of crop will lead to lower production of onion during kharif season.
- As per traders in Maharashtra, farmers who had stored onion thinking that the prices will firm up during monsoon are facing significant losses as stocks have started to rot and prices have not gone up as expected.
- In Purnea (Bihar), onion is mainly coming from Rajasthan and local regions which contribute 70% and 30% respectively to the total arrival. Modal wholesale prices are hovering in the range of Rs800/quintal to Rs. 850/quintal in the last three days. As per market sources prices are expected to increase further.
