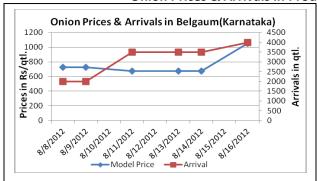
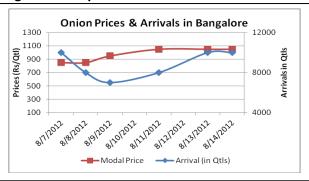

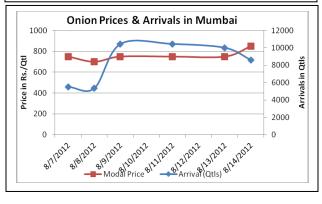
Onion Fundamentals:

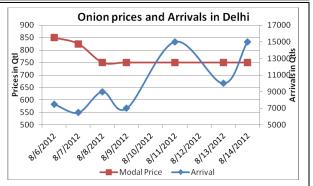
- In Bangalore, onion is mainly coming from Maharashtra region and local regions which are contributing approximately 80% and 20% to the total arrival. Average prices in last two days have increased from Rs 880 to Rs 1050. As per trade sources, prices are expected to increase further in coming days.
- As per news report, the Srilankan government has announced increase in import taxes in big onions.
 The import tax on one kilo of big onions has been increased from 25 rupees to 50 rupees. This
 increase in import tax is for promoting and encouraging to local farmers. This increase in import tax
 will have an impact on export from major producing regions like Lasalgaon, Pimplagaon and
 Bangalore.
- In Belgaum (Karnataka), onion is coming from local region and few traders demand onion from Maharashtra to sell in the local market. On a daily basis, around 10-12 trucks arrives in the local market. Currently prices are hovering in the range of Rs 675 to Rs725 /quintal and expected to rise further.
- In Belgaum (Karnataka) local fresh onion crop from 'Basavan Bagewadi' in Bijapur district will start from August end. Though 1-2 trucks per day are arriving in the market but by the end of this month, arrivals will be in full pace.
