
Market Intelligence System

Onion Fundamentals:

- In all the major onion growing regions like Maharashtra, Rajasthan, and Gujarat, sowing is completed in less than 50% of normal sowing area. Farmers are expecting to recover the sowing area of Kharif season in late kharif.
- In Indore market, onion is mainly arriving from local regions. Major demand for Indore side onions is from North India, especially Delhi and U.P. Average Prices are moving in the range Rs 500 /quintal to Rs 700/ quintal. As per traders, prices are expected to touch Rs 800/quintal in couple of days.
- In Maharashtra and Karnataka late kharif sowing is done till Diwali. Due to deficit monsoon and late arrival of monsoon further sowing is completely dependent upon rain. If the rain falls in good quantity than the area under crop will be recovered by 100% otherwise it may be around 50%-60% only.
- As per traders, Onion prices are likely to rise from current levels of Rs6.75 -8.25 per kilo in the Azadpur wholesale market in Delhi to about Rs 12 /kg after August end. Last year at this time onions were selling near Rs5-6/Kg in Azadpur Mandi.
