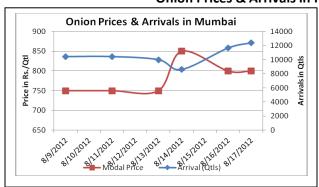
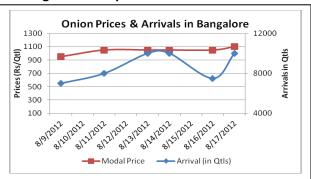
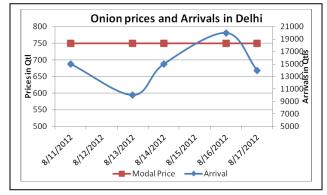
#### **Onion Fundamentals:**

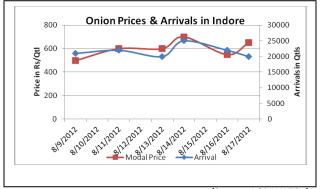
- In Maharashtra, approximately 30000-35000 Kharif sowing is completed this year. Last year at same time sowing was completed in 75000 hectares. Area will be estimated after August or September end only because sowing is totally dependent on further rains.
- According to trade sources in Lasalgaon (Maharashtra), market is picking up its pace from last 4-5 days.
  Average prices have increased from Rs 550/quintal to Rs 750 /quintal irrespective of the demand.
  Further prices are expected to touch a range of Rs 800/ quintal in next few days.
- According to trade sources in Karnataka, framers will try to recover the Kharif area of onion in late kharif as its sowing is delayed due to late arrival of monsoon and deficit rainfall. If it doesn't rain appropriately ahead, probability is that farmers may shift their onion area towards cotton because it requires less water compared to onion.
- Meanwhile, in retail market prices are hovering in the range of Rs700/quintal-Rs1800/quintal.
  Maximum pieces were seen in Guwahati followed by Trivandrum and Mumbai where prices were Rs1800, Rs1700 and Rs1600 respectively.
