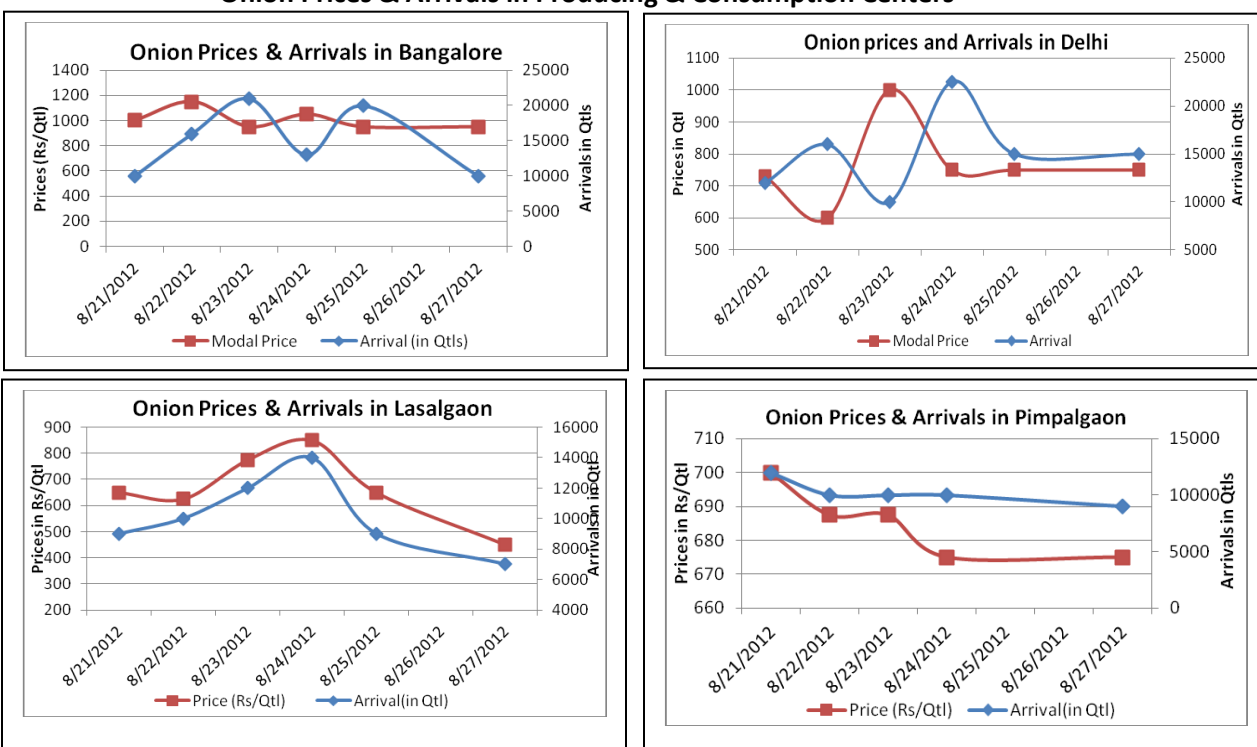


Onion Fundamentals:

- In Jaipur, onion is mainly coming from local areas like Kota and Mathania. According to trade sources, average arrivals have decreased by approximately 40 % due to heavy rains. Prices are expected to increase in coming days.
- According to trade sources in Kurnool (Andhra Pradesh), approximately 80% of kharif sowing is completed as compared to last year's 90% at this time. Total Kharif area in Kurnool is approximately 17000 hectares.
- According to trade sources, onion production in Kharif season is likely to fall by 25% to 35% as compared to last year's production. Exact estimation could be made after 15th September only. The onion harvest will be delayed by a month as sowing started in late July and arrivals will start only by the end of October.
