

Onion Fundamentals:

- In Bangalore, onion from local region is coming from Chitradurga district. Prices are declined as arrivals have increased because farmers are releasing maximum of their stocked onions as new crop is expected to arrive in market approximately after two weeks.
- According to trade sources in Pimplagaon (Maharashtra), traders are not releasing much of their stocked onion because they are expecting rise in prices after mid September. So, average arrivals from last five days are hovering in the range of 12000 quintals to 16000 quintals.
- Export of onion from Pimplagaon on weekly basis is approximately 5000 quintal. According to trade sources, major demand comes from Colombo and Malaysia. Exporters are expecting prices to increase both in domestic and international market in near future.
