


#### **Onion Fundamentals:**


- Delay in onion sowing due to deficient rains in the key growing states of Maharashtra and Karnataka is expected to hit supplies by mid-October and push up retail prices. Currently prices are hovering in the range of Rs /quintal to Rs /quintal all across the country.
- According to trade sources in Lasalgaon and Pimpalgaon, traders have stored the onion because of their expectations that prices are expected to increase from September because of late arrival of khariff crop which usually arrives in market in month of October and November.
- In Ahmadabad onion is coming from local region and Maharashtra region. Prices are hovering in the range of Rs 550 to Rs750 /quintal and traders are expecting prices to increase in next few days.
- According to trade sources, arrivals are expected to increase in next few days in Nasik region as it's
  raining there so, farmers are likely to release their stock as after rains the chances of onion crop to
  get spoil is more.
