



Onion Fundamentals:


- In Belgaum (Karnataka), onion is mainly coming from Bagewadi (local region) and Maharashtra which are contributing 705 and 30% respectively. Prices are hovering in the range of Rs
- According to trade sources in Belgaum, local stored onion which is simultaneously coming with local produced fresh crop of onion. On a daily basis 2-3 trucks fresh onion is arriving in market and is likely to pick up the pace in a couple of days.
- In major consumption centers like Delhi, Mumbai and Bangalore arrivals have increased in last 2-3 days because of increase in demand. According to trade sources, prices of onion are likely to increase after mid September irrespective of the arrival in market.
- According to trade sources Kharif and early kharif both crop are one month delay in this season because of delay in monsoon and deficit rainfall. Prices are likely to increase in couple of days.
