



#### **Onion Fundamentals:**


- According to trade sources, export demand has increased in Nasik region. On an average per day 25-30 trucks are being exported from Nasik only. Demand is mainly coming from countries like Malaysia and Bangkok.
- In Pimplagaon (Maharashtra) market, average prices have fallen from Rs 650/quintal to approximately Rs 575/ quintal in last few days. According to trade sources, farmers/traders are bringing their low quality or damaged stocks to market which is much lower than anticipated. So, it results into decline in prices.
- In Belgaum market, prices of onion has increased by Rs 100/ quintal compared to previous day prices Rs 600/ quintal due to decrease in arrival from local region 'Basavan Bagewadi' as it rained their and spoiled the stocked crop. Yesterday, Onion mainly arrived from Maharashtra only and a few quantities from local region.
