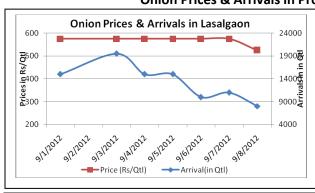
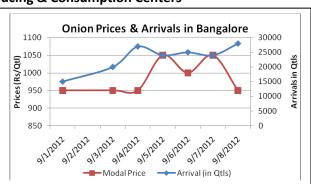

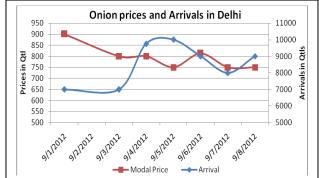
Onion Fundamentals:

- Low quality onion arrival is reported in different mandis of Maharashtra as farmers are holding back their good quality for higher price in coming month.
- Due to poor quality onion, prices are stable and softened a bit across major markets.
- There is good demand for onion coming from Chitradurga from West Bengal and Tamil Nadu.
- As per NAFED sources, India has exported around 7.9 Lakh MT till Aug end. As per our analysis, further 5-6 Lakh MT of onion could be exported till the end of FY 2012-13.
- In Rajkot, onion is coming from Nasik and Local region which are contributing 40% and 60% of the total arrival. Prices are hovering in the range of Rs 600 to Rs 850 /quintal and further expected to increase.
- Retail prices in majority of the cities are hovering in between Rs. 1000-1500/Qtl where as wholesale prices are trading in the range of Rs. 800-1000/Qtl.
- Onion prices could rise during end of October due to demand supply mismatch as kharif crop arrival could be delayed this year due to late sowing in producing region.
