



#### **Onion Fundamentals:**


- In Pimplagaon and Lasalgaon market, average prices of onion have fallen to Rs 525/ quintal and Rs600/ quintal from Rs 575 / quintal to Rs 625 / quintal respectively in last 2- 3 days. According to trade sources, prices of onion have fallen down because resurgence of monsoon has increased the fear of decay of crop in storages. So farmers are releasing their stock as early as possible.
- In Bangalore, prices have fallen to Rs 1050 / quintal from Rs 1150 / quintal in last two days. According to trade sources, demand of stored onion is not much as low quality onion is arriving in market. Average prices have fallen to Rs 950 from Rs 1050 / quintal in last 4-5 days.
- In Bangalore, onion is coming from ChitraDurga and Bijapur districts only. Major demand comes from West Bengal and Tamil Nadu. According to trade sources, demand of Chitradurga origin is more compared to Bijapur origin onion.
- In Rajkot, onion is coming from Nasik and Local region which are contributing 40% and 60% of the total arrival. Prices are hovering in the range of Rs 500 to Rs 650 /quintal and further expected to increase.
