


## **Onion Fundamentals:**


- According to trade sources, in all the major regions of Maharashtra region like Nasik, Pimpalgaon, Lasalgaon, Ahmednagar and Pune, prices of onion have fallen down because resurgence of monsoon has increased the fear of decay of crop in storages. So farmers are releasing their stock as early as possible.
- Retail prices in majority of the cities are hovering in between Rs. 1000-1500/Qtl where as wholesale prices are trading in the range of Rs. 800-1000/Qtl.
- In Belgaum (Karnataka), prices have fallen to Rs650/ quintal from Rs725/ quintal as local produced potato are available in market. Prices are likely to remain stable throughout the week.
- In Lasalgaon and Pimpalgaon market, export demand has declined because of arrival of low quality and damaged crop in market. According to trade sources, farmers are holding their crop as much they can because prices are likely to increase in coming weeks as a shortfall may occur from month of October onward due to diminishing stocks and delay of kharif crop by one month.
