


#### **Onion Fundamentals:**


- In Karnataka, local origin fresh onion has started arriving in market. According to trade sources, arrivals of fresh onion is expected to be in full pace in couple of weeks. Prices are hovering in the range of Rs 650/quintal to Rs 725/ quintal but further expected to increase.
- In Indore, prices of onion are low which are hovering in the range of Rs 400/ quintal to Rs 700/ quintal from last few weeks because average arrivals in markets has increased to 25000- 30000 bags (60 kg each) compared to previous year's 10000- 15000 bags (60kg each) per day at same time.
- According to trade sources in Lasalgaon, farmers are still holding good crop of onions and releasing damaged and low quality of onion in market. Because of low quality onion, average prices have declined to Rs 475/ quintal compared to previous week Rs 525 / quintal.
- In Rajkot, onion is coming from Nasik and Local region which are contributing 40% and 60% of the total arrival. Prices are hovering in the range of Rs 500 to Rs 650 /quintal and further expected to increase.
