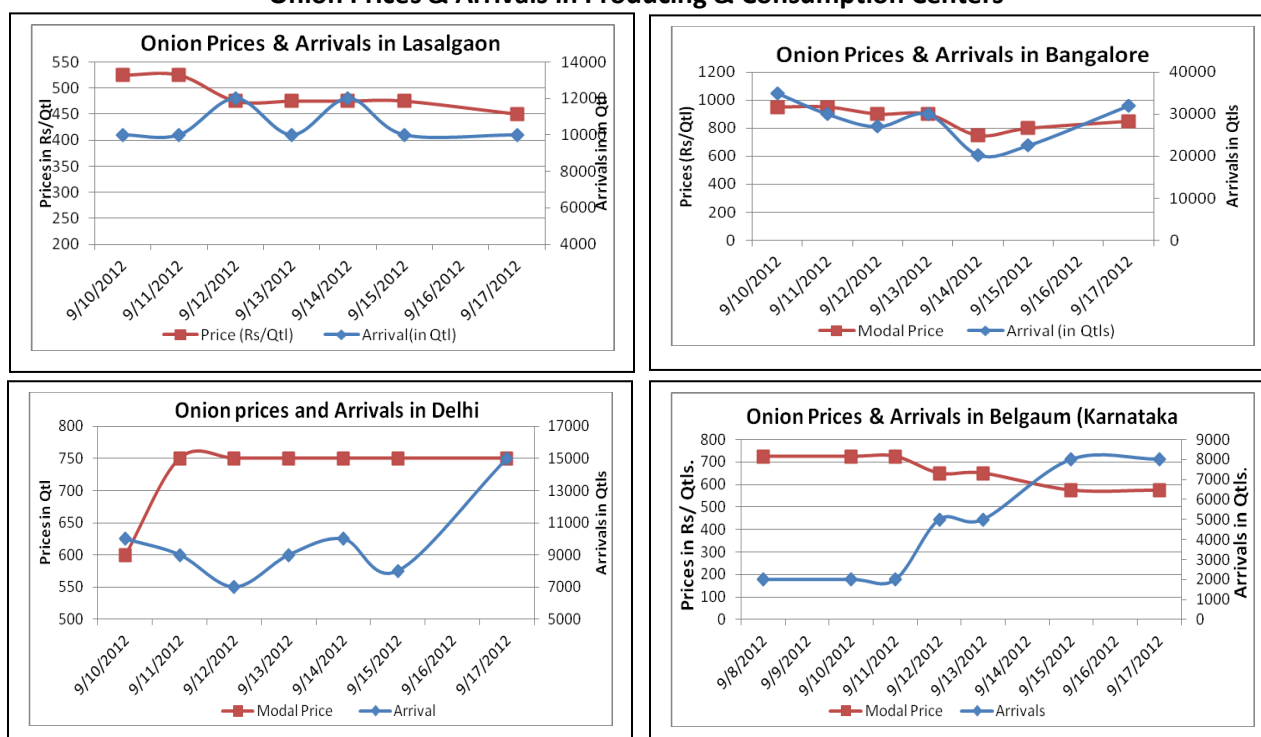


## Onion Fundamentals:

- In Belgaum (Karnataka), mandi which opens twice a week, Wednesday and Friday. According to trade sources, arrivals of onion increased to 8000 quintals from 5000 quintals on last Friday. The arrivals were increased by approximately 38% because market is closed on next working day (Wednesday) on the occasion of Ganesh Chaturthi.
- According to trade sources, exports of onion from country increased by 22 % in volume during April-August but dropped in value by 27% compared to last year. This Year on date 3-09-12 approximately 796329 ton of onion has been exported.
- According to NHRDF, approximately 53% area in Haryana (2000 ha) and 44% area in Bihar (1200 ha) is expected to be covered under kharif onion as compared to previous year, whereas in Uttar Pradesh around 80% area under kharif onion (3000 ha) expected to be covered.
