


### **Onion Fundamentals:**


- According to trade sources, onion sowing in Maharashtra is completed by 50% -60% of the total Kharif area which is approximately 75000 hectares. It was expected that area would covered in late kharif but still there is no rains in Maharashtra. Estimation of total sowing area will be made after end of this month as farmers are expecting rains by the end of months.
- According to trade sources, August and September are periods when exports slow in view of monsoon. Also, it is when farmers generally tend to run out of stocks or would prefer to push only those grades that are vulnerable to damage which result into decline in exports.
- A feature of this year's export has been that shipments were over 1.5 lakh tons every month, barring August when it dropped to 83000 tons. One reason for the drop was buyers placing lower orders in view of monsoon, while poor quality of arrivals was another reason.
