


Onion Fundamentals:


- The National Horticultural Research and Development Foundation (NHRDF), Sangvi, has developed a new dark red onion variety known as NHRDF-red (L-28). According them, it is suitable for cultivation in Northern, Central and Western India. It matures in 115-120 days after transplanting and the average yield is about 25 to 30 tons per hectare.
- In Belgaum, local origin fresh onion has started arriving in market which is contributing around 30 % whereas local stored onion is contributing approximately 68% and rest 2% is coming from Maharashtra.
- According to trade sources in Belgaum (Karnataka), stored onion will be available in market till 1st week
 of October and after that it is expected that arrivals of fresh onion will pick up pace.
- In Indore, demand for onion mainly comes from U.P, Kolkata and Assam. Prices are hovering in the range of Rs 400 to Rs 600 /quintal compared to last year's Rs1200/quintal at the same time.
