


#### **Onion Fundamentals:**


- In Bangalore onion is coming from local region and Maharashtra region which are contributing approximately 80 % and 20% respectively to the total arrival. Prices have fallen to Rs 850/quintal from Rs 900/ quintal in last one week as fresh local produced onion is arriving in market which has reduced the transportation cost and results into decline in prices.
- According to trade sources, newly-harvested crop is now available in Karnataka and Andhra Pradesh.
   Southern states are also Supplying to West Bengal and Orissa, replacing the Maharashtra onion, which has also affected the decline in prices in Maharashtra state.
- According to trade sources in Lasalgaon, against an average of 110-130 truck a day, 60-70 truck of
  onions are being brought to market now. The reason is that damaged or rotten crop they have cleared
  and good quality onion they have kept to fetch high prices in future as kharif crop is delayed by one
  month.
