


### **Onion Fundamentals:**


- In Ahmadabad, onion is mainly coming from Maharashtra and local region (Saurashtra) which are contributing approximately 90 % and 10% to the total arrival. Prices are hovering in the range of Rs 950/ quintal to Rs 1450 / quintal and are likely to increase in coming days.
- In Pimpalgaon, arrivals have declined to 11500 quintals from 15000 quintals in last three days whereas prices have also fallen to Rs 560/ quintal from Rs 600/ quintal. Arrival and prices are declining because of slow market and arrival of fresh onion from southern region.
- According to trade sources, onion prices are expected to move up as from mid October as kharif crop
  is less by 20-25% compared to last year's crop and the arrival of crop is also late due to delayed
  sowing.
- In Bangalore, arrivals increased to 30000 quintals from 22500 quintals in last 2-3 days. Due to this increase in arrivals, prices fall down to Rs 800/ quintal from Rs 900/ quintal.
