Market Intelligence System

Onion Fundamentals:

- In Delhi, onion is mainly coming from M.P, Rajasthan and Maharashtra which are contributing approximately 45%, 30% and 25% to the total arrival. Prices are hovering in the range of Rs 700 to Rs 800/ quintal and expected to remain stable throughout the week.
- In Mumbai, prices are stable and hovering in the range of Rs 650 to Rs 750 / quintal from last 4-5 days irrespective of the arrivals. According to trade sources, prices are expected to increase in couple of days.
- Across the country, prices are not showing much fluctuation and are not varying much with the arrivals which indicate that demand is low in market.
- According to trade sources, newly-harvested crop is now available in Karnataka and Andhra Pradesh. Southern states are supplying to West Bengal and Orissa which has replaced the demand of Maharashtra region and has affected the supply.
