

## Onion Fundamentals:

- In Belgaum (Karnataka), approximately 95% of onion is mainly coming from Local region whereas Maharashtra region is contributing only 5% to the total arrival. According to trade sources, major demand comes from Kolkata. Traders are expecting export demand after mid October.
- In Bangalore (Karnataka), prices have increased to Rs850/ quintal from Rs650/ quintal against lower arrival of onion from local region. Prices are likely to remain stable throughout the week.
- In retail market, onion is hovering in the range of Rs 900 to Rs 1800 / quintal. Maximum prices were seen in Guwahati at Rs 1800/ quintal followed by Chennai and Shimla at Rs 1600 and Rs 1500/ quintal respectively.
- In all the major markets across the country, prices are stable and irrespective of the arrival. In Lasalgaon arrivals have fallen to 6000 quintal from 8500 quintal because farmers/traders are holding good quality of onion in expectation of high prices in near future.
